Population of Municipality of Bato (Based on the Results of 2015 Census of Population)

The population of Bato as of 2015 is 52,137

- Bato's population as of August 1, 2015 was 52,137, based on the 2015 Census of Population (POPCEN2015). The municipality is the 17th most populous city/municipality of Camarines Sur.
- The 2015 population is higher by 3,831 compared with the population of 48,306 in 2010, and by 9,398 compared with the population of 42,739 in 2000.

- From 2010 to 2015, the population of Bato increased by 1.46 percent annually, on average. By comparison, the rate at which the municipality's population grew during the period 2000 to 2010 was lower at 1.23 percent.

- Bato has 33 barangays. Barangay San Vicente had the biggest population of 6,596 persons in 2015 and accounted for about 12.65 percent of the municipality's population. It was followed by Barangay San Miguel with 3,969, and Barangay Santiago (Pob.) with 3,768 persons. The combined population of these three barangays accounted for about 27.49 percent of the population of Bato in 2015.
- Barangay Manga (Mangga) was the smallest barangay in 2015, in terms of population size, with 275 persons. It was followed by Barangay Lubigan with 280 persons.

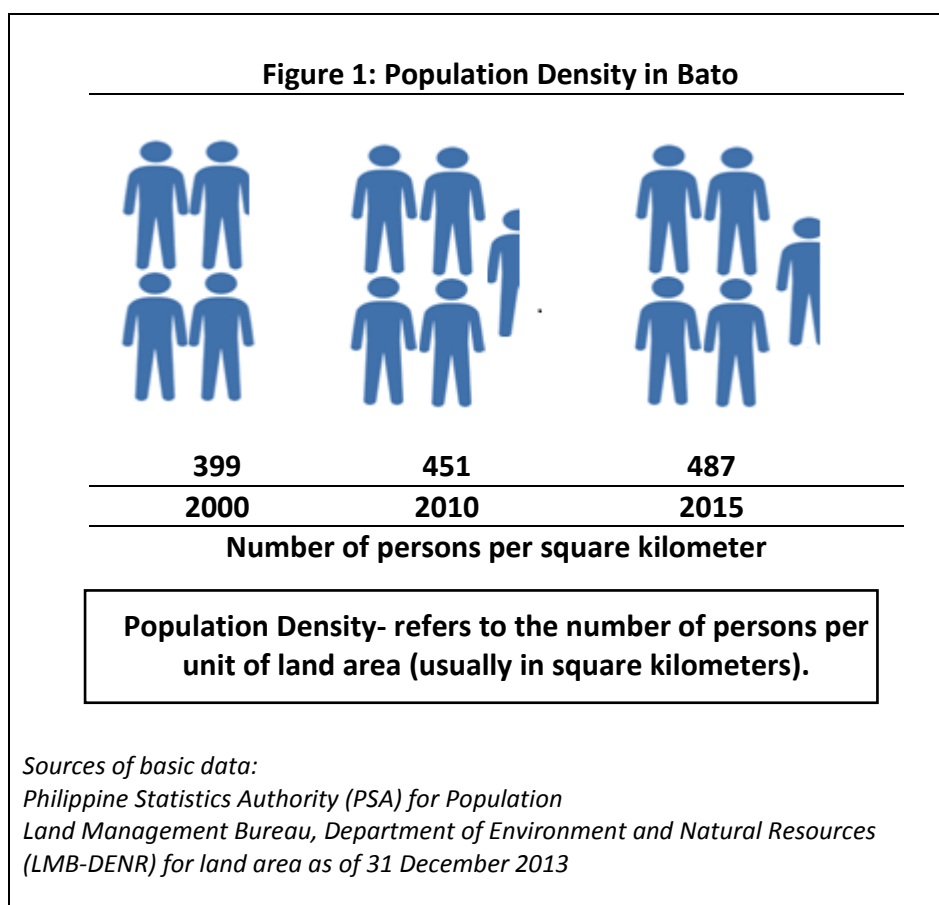

Population density in Bato increases from 451 to 487 persons per square kilometer

- With a total land area of approximately 107.12 square kilometers, the population density of Bato in 2015 was posted at 487 persons per square kilometer. This represents an increase of 36 persons per square kilometer from the population density of 451 persons per square kilometer in 2010. In 2000, there were about 399 persons residing in every square kilometer of land in the municipality.



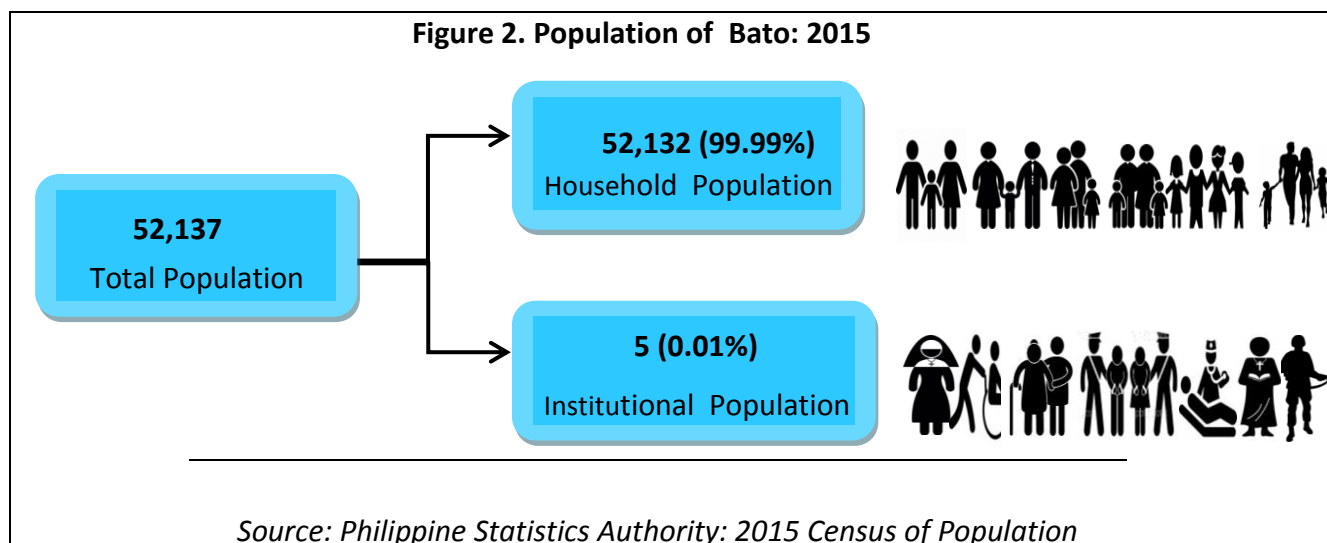
Household Population comprised 99.99 percent of the total population

- The household population of Bato reached 52,132 persons in 2015. This is 3,839 higher than the 48,293 household population reported in 2010, and 9,420 more than the 42,712 household population posted in 2000.

- The household population comprised 99.99 percent of the total population in Bato, while remaining 0.01 percent comprised the institutional population or those residing in collective or institutional living quarters such as hotels, hospitals, orphanages and home for the aged, corrective and penal institutions and military camps.



Number of households increased by 747 from 9,122 in 2010 to 9,869 in 2015

- The total number of households in Bato in 2015 was recorded at 9,869 higher by 747 households compared with 9,122 in 2010 and higher by 2,132 compared with 7,737 in 2000.

Average household size was 5.28 persons in 2015

- Average household size (AHS) in Bato decreased from 5.29 persons in 2010 to 5.28 persons in 2015. In 2000, there were 5.52 persons, on average, per household.

- From 2000 to 2015, while the household population and number of household are increasing, the average household size is decreasing.
- The reported household population of this municipality in 2015 is higher by 8 percent compared to its 2010 count. While from 2000 to 2010, its household population increased by 13 percent.
