Population of Municipality of Bombon (Based on the Results of 2015 Census of Population)

The population of Bombon as of 2015 is 16,512

- Bombon's population as of August 1, 2015 was 16,512, based on the 2015 Census of Population (POPCEN2015). The municipality is the second least populous city/municipality of Camarines Sur.
- The 2015 population is higher by 1,075 compared with the population of 15,437 in 2010, and by 3,669 compared with the population of 12,843 in 2000.

- From 2010 to 2015, the population of Bombon increased by 1.29 percent annually, on average. By comparison, the rate at which the municipality's population grew during the period 2000 to 2010 was higher at 1.86 percent.

- Bombon has 8 barangays. Barangay San Antonio had the biggest population of 4,156 persons in 2015 and accounted for about 25.17 percent of the municipality's population. It was followed by Barangay San Roque (Pob.) with 2,611, and Barangay San Francisco with 2,304 persons. The combined population of these three barangays accounted for about 54.94 percent of the population of Bombon in 2015.
- Barangay Pagao (San Juan) was the smallest barangay in 2015, in terms of population size, with 468 persons. It was followed by Barangay San Isidro (Pob.) with 1,249 persons.

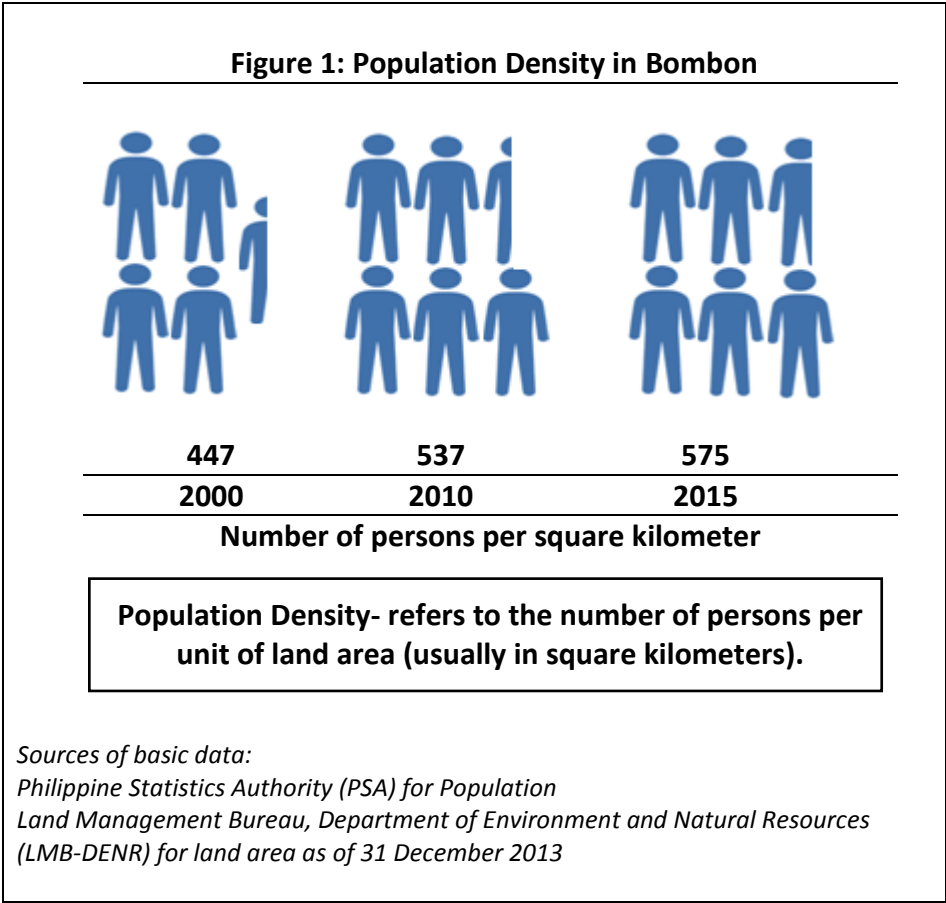

Population density in Bombon increases from 537 to 575 persons per square kilometer

- With a total land area of approximately 28.73 square kilometers, the population density of Bombon in 2015 was posted at 575 persons per square kilometer. This represents an increase of 38 persons per square kilometer from the population density of 537 persons per square kilometer in 2010. In 2000, there were about 447 persons residing in every square kilometer of land in the municipality.



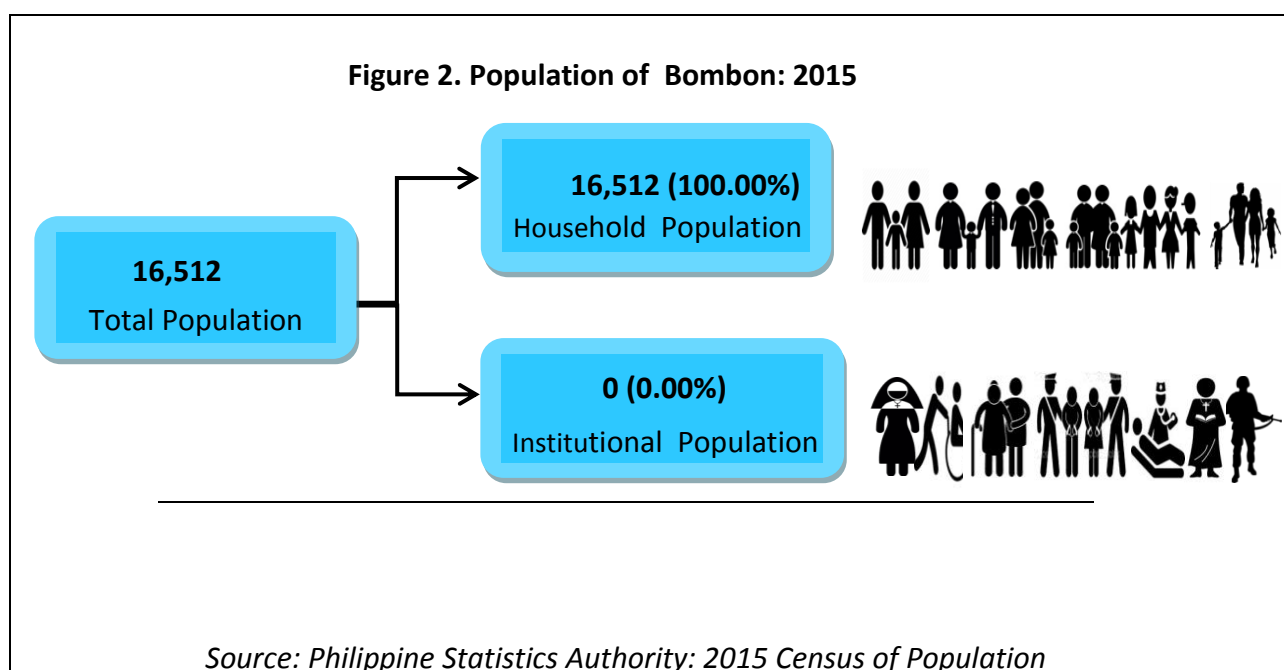
Household Population in 2015 is equal the total population

- The household population of Bombon reached 16,512 persons in 2015. This is 1,078 higher than the 15,434 household population reported in 2010, and 3,672 more than the 12,840 household population posted in 2000.

- In 2015, the household population in Bombon is equal to the total population which means that no person was reported to be residing in collective or institutional living quarters such as hotels, hospitals, orphanages and home for the aged, corrective and penal institutions and military camps.



Population of Municipality of Bombon (Based on the Results of 2015 Census of Population)

Average household size was 4.77 persons in 2015

- Average household size (AHS) in Bombon slightly decreased from 4.85 persons in 2010 to 4.77 persons in 2015. In 2000, there were 5.50 persons, on average, per household.

- From 2000 to 2015, while the household population and number of household are increasing, the average household size is decreasing.
- The reported household population of this municipality in 2015 is higher by 7 percent compared to its 2010 count. While from 2000 to 2010, its household population increased by 20 percent.
