Population of Municipality of Canaman (Based on the Results of 2015 Census of Population)

The population of Canaman as of 2015 is 34,210

- Canaman's population as of August 1, 2015 was 34,210, based on the 2015 Census of Population (POPCEN2015). The municipality ranks 25th among the 37 city/municipality of Camarines Sur.
- The 2015 population is higher by 1,820 compared with the population of 32,390 in 2010, and by 6,491 compared with the population of 27,719 in 2000.

- From 2010 to 2015, the population of Canaman increased by 1.05 percent annually, on average. By comparison, the rate at which the municipality's population grew during the period 2000 to 2010 was higher at 1.57 percent.

(Based on the Results of 2015 Census of Population)

- Canaman has 24 barangays. Barangay Del Rosario had the biggest population of 3,941 persons in 2015 and accounted for about 11.52 percent of the municipality's population. It was followed by Barangay San Vicente with 2,982, and Barangay Haring with 2,490 persons. The combined population of these three barangays accounted for about 27.52 percent of the population of Canaman in 2015.
- Barangay San Juan was the smallest barangay in 2015, in terms of population size, with 232 persons. It was followed by Barangay San Jose East with 442 persons.

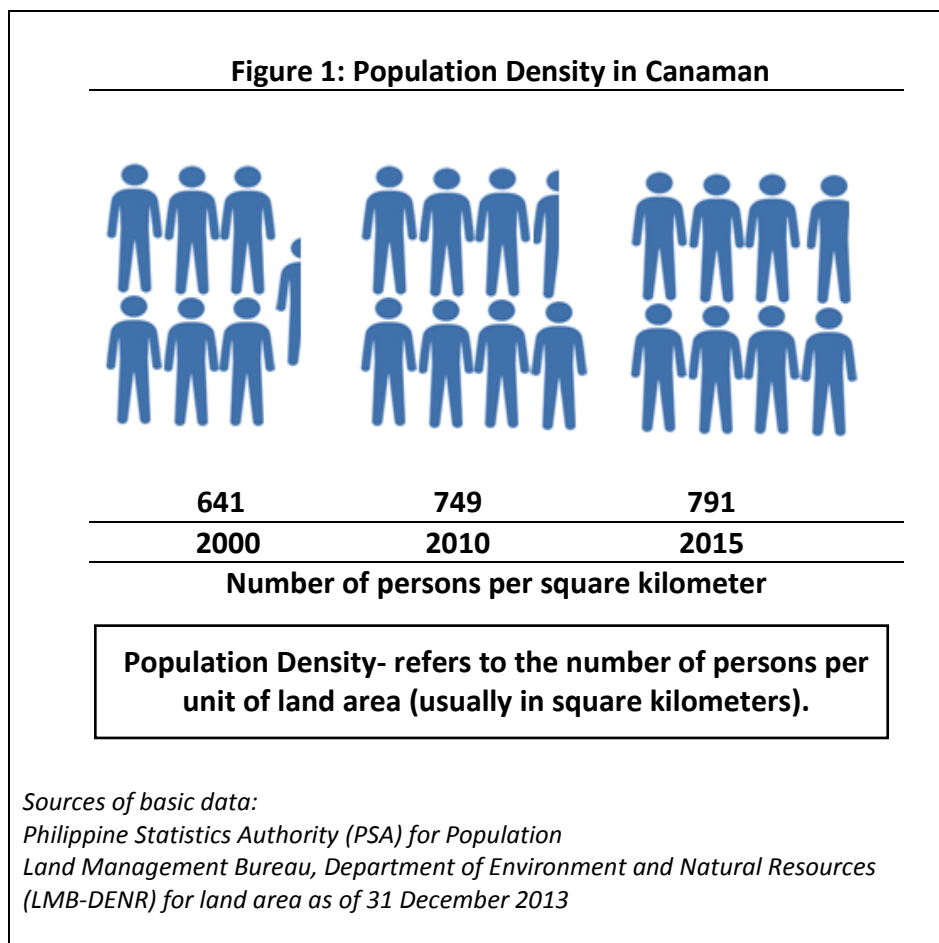

Population density in Canaman increases from 749 to 791 persons per square kilometer

- With a total land area of approximately 43.27 square kilometers, the population density of Canaman in 2015 was posted at 791 persons per square kilometer. This represents an increase of 42 persons per square kilometer from the population density of 749 persons per square kilometer in 2010. In 2000, there were about 641 persons residing in every square kilometer of land in the municipality.



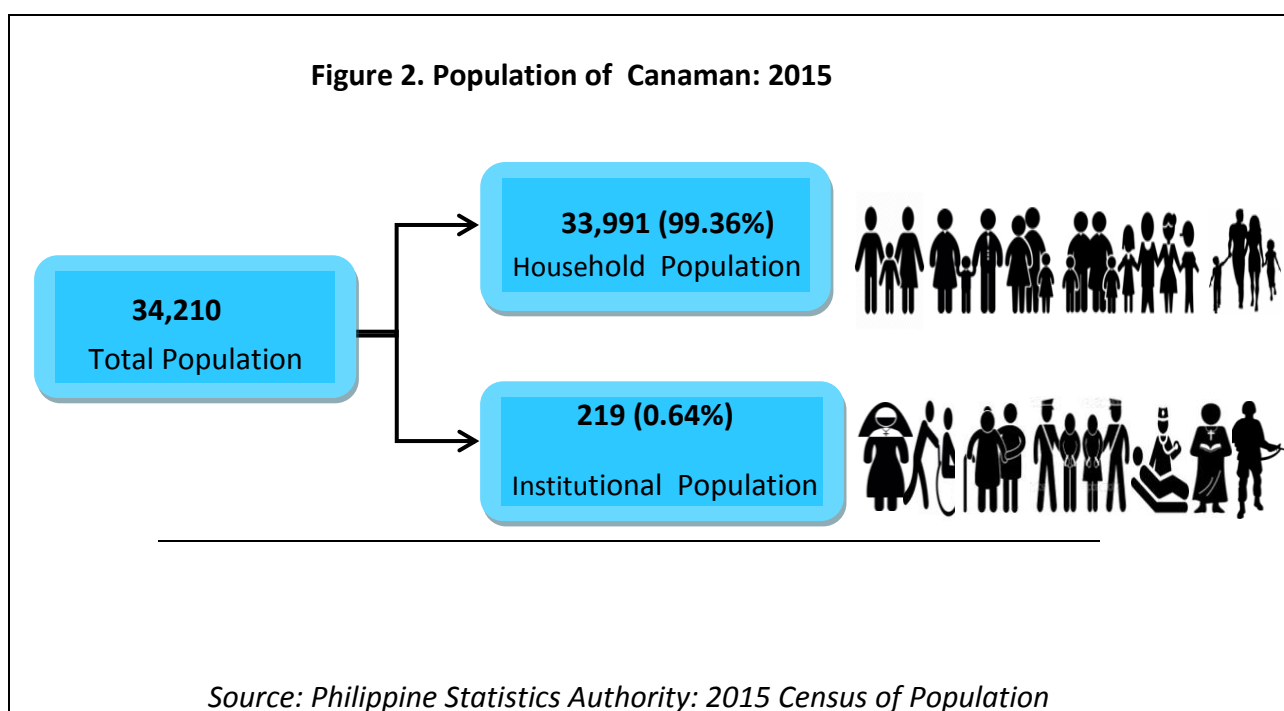
Household Population comprised 99.36 percent of the total population

- The household population of Canaman reached 33,991 persons in 2015. This is 1,607 higher than the 32,384 household population reported in 2010, and 6,272 more than the 27,719 household population posted in 2000.

- The household population comprised 99.36 percent of the total population in Canaman, while remaining 0.64 percent comprised the institutional population or those residing in collective or institutional living quarters such as hotels, hospitals, orphanages and home for the aged, corrective and penal institutions and military camps.



Population of Municipality of Canaman (Based on the Results of 2015 Census of Population)

Average household size was 4.79 persons in 2015

- Average household size (AHS) in Canaman slightly decreased from 4.92 persons in 2010 to 4.79 persons in 2015. In 2000, there were 5.32 persons, on average, per household.

- From 2000 to 2015, while the household population and number of household are increasing, the average household size is decreasing.
- The reported household population of this municipality in 2015 is higher by 5 percent compared to its 2010 count. While from 2000 to 2010, its household population increased by 17 percent.
