### **Population of the Municipality of Goa (Based on the Results of 2015 Census of Population)**

*The population of Goa as of 2015 is 63,308*

- Goa's population as of August 1, 2015 was 63,308, based on the 2015 Census of Population (POPCEN2015). The municipality ranks 11th among the 37 city/municipality of Camarines Sur.
- The 2015 population is higher by 4,805 compared with the population of 58,503 in 2010, and by 14,818 compared with the population of 48,490 in 2000.

- From 2010 to 2015, the population of Goa increased by 1.52 percent annually, on average. By comparison, the rate at which the municipality's population grew during the period 2000 to 2010 was higher at 1.89 percent.

- Goa has 34 barangays. Barangay Matacla had the biggest population of 4,662 persons in 2015 and accounted for about 7.36 percent of the municipality's population. It was followed by Barangay Buyo with 3,967, and Barangay Catagbacan with 3,915 persons. The combined population of these three barangays accounted for about 19.81 percent of the population of Goa in 2015.
- Barangay Tamban (Mabini) was the smallest barangay in 2015, in terms of population size, with 378 persons. It was followed by Barangay Scout Fuentebella with 643 persons.

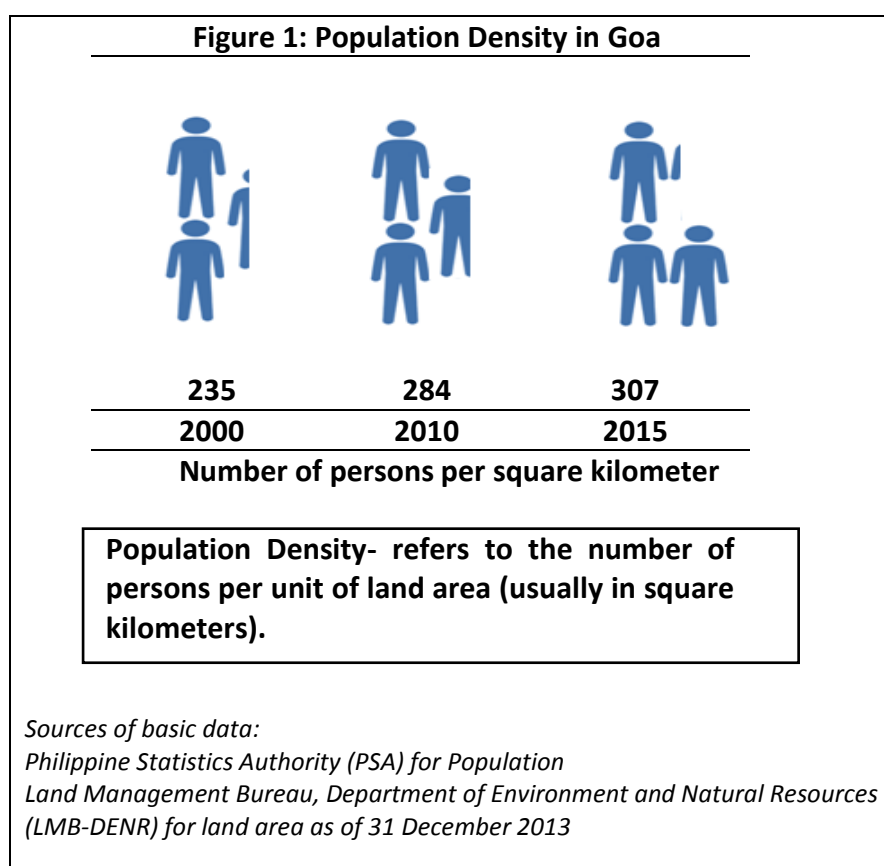

### **Population density in Goa increases from 284 to 307 persons per square kilometer**

- With a total land area of approximately 206.18 square kilometers, the population density of Goa in 2015 was posted at 307 persons per square kilometer. This represents an increase of 23 persons per square kilometer from the population density of 284 persons per square kilometer in 2010. In 2000, there were about 235 persons residing in every square kilometer of land in the municipality.



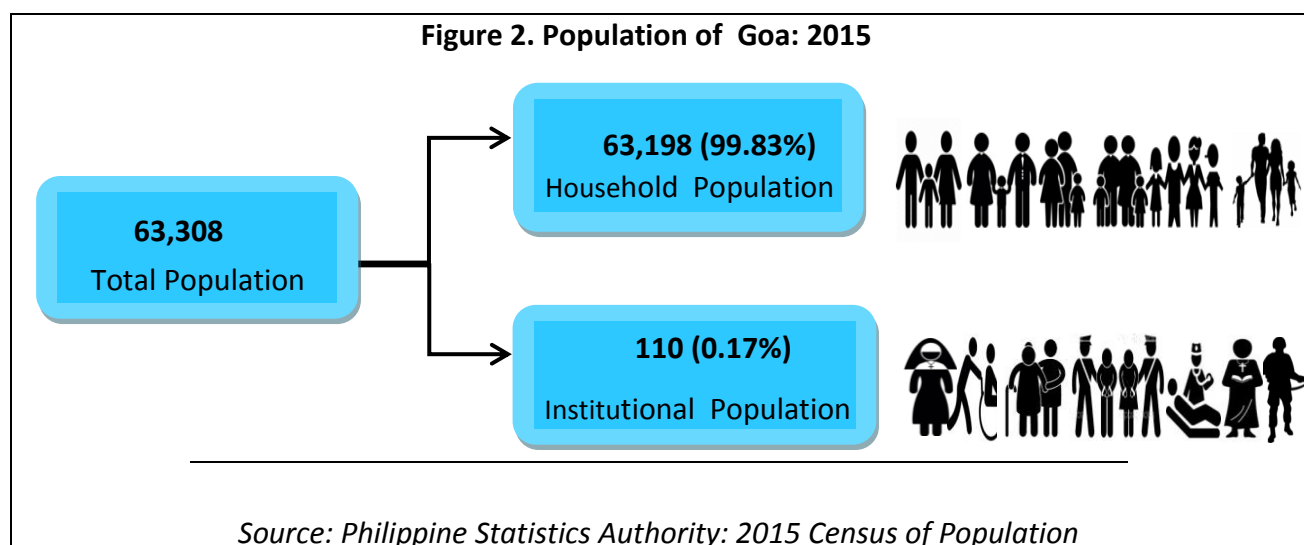
### **Household Population comprised 99.83 percent of the total population**

- The household population of Goa reached 63,198 persons in 2015. This is 4,737 higher than the 58,461 household population reported in 2010, and 14,749 more than the 48,449 household population posted in 2000.

- The household population comprised 99.83 percent of the total population in Goa, while remaining 0.17 percent comprised the institutional population or those residing in collective or institutional living quarters such as hotels, hospitals, orphanages and home for the aged, corrective and penal institutions and military camps.



### **Number of households increased by 1,142 from 11,700 in 2010 to 12,842 in 2015**

- The total number of households in Goa in 2015 was recorded at 12,842 higher by 1,142 households compared with 11,700 in 2010 and higher by 3,703 compared with 9,139 in 2000.

**Average household size was 4.92 persons in 2015**

- Average household size (AHS) in Goa slightly decreased from 5 persons in 2010 to 4.92 persons in 2015. In 2000, there were 5.30 persons, on average, per household.

- From 2000 to 2015, while the household population and number of household are increasing, the average household size is decreasing.
- The reported household population of this municipality in 2015 is higher by 8 percent compared to its 2010 count. While from 2000 to 2010, its household population increased by 21 percent.
