Population of the Municipality of Camaligan (Based on the Results of 2015 Census of Population)

The population of Camaligan as of 2015 is 24,109

- Camaligan's population as of August 1, 2015 was 24,109, based on the 2015 Census of Population (POPCEN2015). The municipality is the sixth least populous city/municipality of Camarines Sur.
- The 2015 population is higher by 1,855 compared with the population of 22,254 in 2010, and by 4,921 compared with the population of 19,188 in 2000.

- From 2010 to 2015, the population of Camaligan increased by 1.54 percent annually, on average. By comparison, the rate at which the municipality's population grew during the period 2000 to 2010 was lower at 1.49 percent.

- Camaligan has 13 barangays. Barangay Marupit had the biggest population of 4,510 persons in 2015 and accounted for about 18.71 percent of the municipality's population. It was followed by Barangay Dugcal with 4,464, and Barangay San Roque with 3,585 persons. The combined population of these three barangays accounted for about 52.09 percent of the population of Camaligan in 2015.
- Barangay San Lucas (Pob.) was the smallest barangay in 2015, in terms of population size, with 578 persons. It was followed by Barangay Santo Domingo (Pob.) with 618 persons.

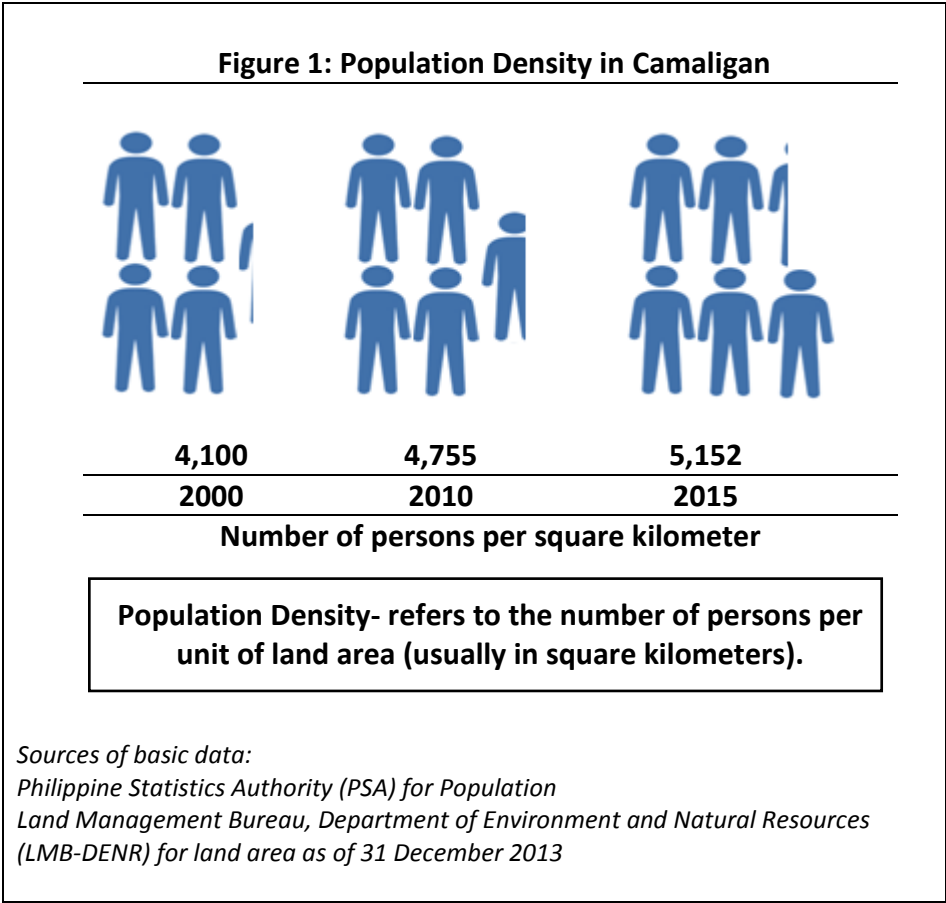

Population density in Camaligan increases from 4,755 to 5,152 persons per square kilometer

- With a total land area of approximately 4.68 square kilometers, the population density of Camaligan in 2015 was posted at 5,152 persons per square kilometer. This represents an increase of 397 persons per square kilometer from the population density of 4,755 persons per square kilometer in 2010. In 2000, there were about 4,100 persons residing in every square kilometer of land in the municipality.



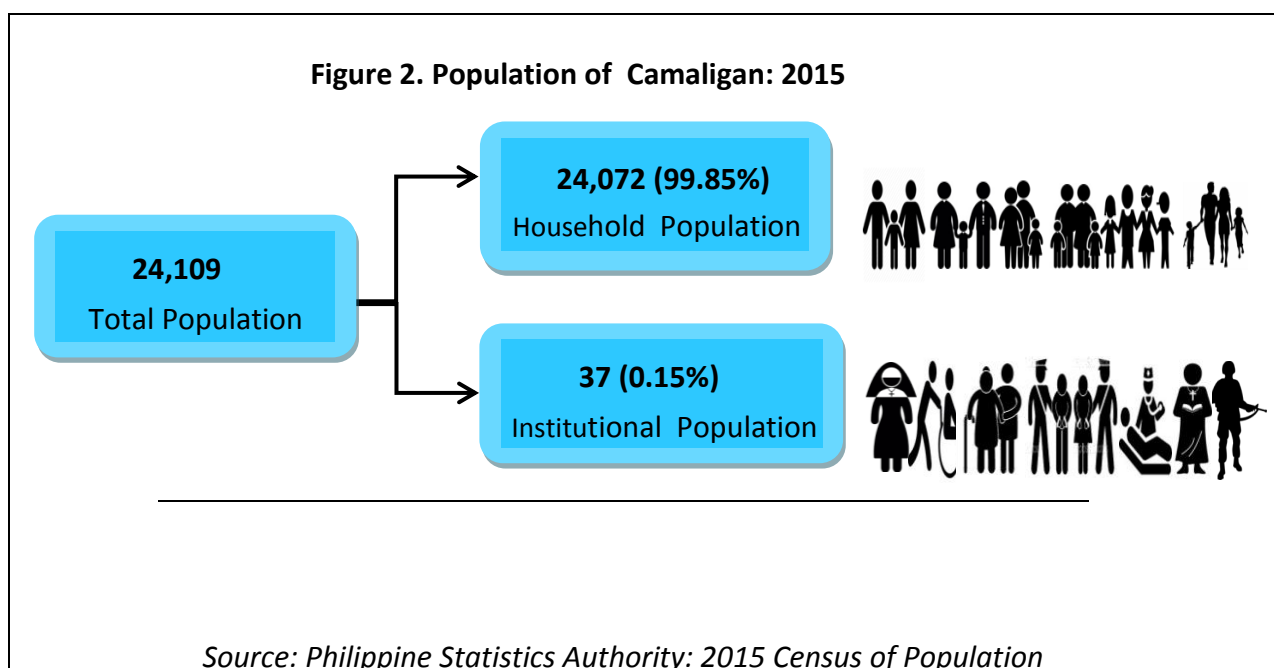
Household Population comprised 99.85 percent of the total population

- The household population of Camaligan reached 24,072 persons in 2015. This is 1,826 higher than the 22,246 household population reported in 2010, and 4,898 more than the 19,174 household population posted in 2000.

- The household population comprised 99.85 percent of the total population in Camaligan, while remaining 0.15 percent comprised the institutional population or those residing in collective or institutional living quarters such as hotels, hospitals, orphanages and home for the aged, corrective and penal institutions and military camps.



Population of the Municipality of Camaligan (Based on the Results of 2015 Census of Population)

Average household size was 4.97 persons in 2015

- Average household size (AHS) in Camaligan slightly increased from 4.91 persons in 2010 to 4.97 persons in 2015. In 2000, there were 5.59 persons, on average, per household.

- From 2000 to 2015, the household population and number of household are increasing.
- The reported household population of this municipality in 2015 is higher by 8 percent compared to its 2010 count. While from 2000 to 2010, its household population increased by 16 percent.
