2015 Population

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Population of the Municipality of Pamplona (Based on the Results of 2015 Census of Population)

The population of Pamplona as of 2015 is 36,390

- Pamplona's population as of August 1, 2015 was 36,390, based on the 2015 Census of Population (POPCEN2015). The municipality ranks 22nd among the 37 city/municipality of Camarines Sur.
- The 2015 population is higher by 1,919 compared with the population of 34,471 in 2010, and by 7,213 compared with the population of 29,177 in 2000.

- From 2010 to 2015, the population of Pamplona increased by 1.04 percent annually, on average. By comparison, the rate at which the municipality's population grew during the period 2000 to 2010 was higher at 1.68 percent.

- Pamplona has 17 barangays. Barangay Poblacion had the biggest population of 5,209 persons in 2015 and accounted for about 14.31 percent of the municipality's population. It was followed by Barangay Tambo with 3,928, and Barangay San Vicente with 3,901 persons. The combined population of these three barangays accounted for about 35.83 percent of the population of Pamplona in 2015.
- Barangay San Rafael was the smallest barangay in 2015, in terms of population size, with 328 persons. It was followed by Barangay Cagbibi with 446 persons.

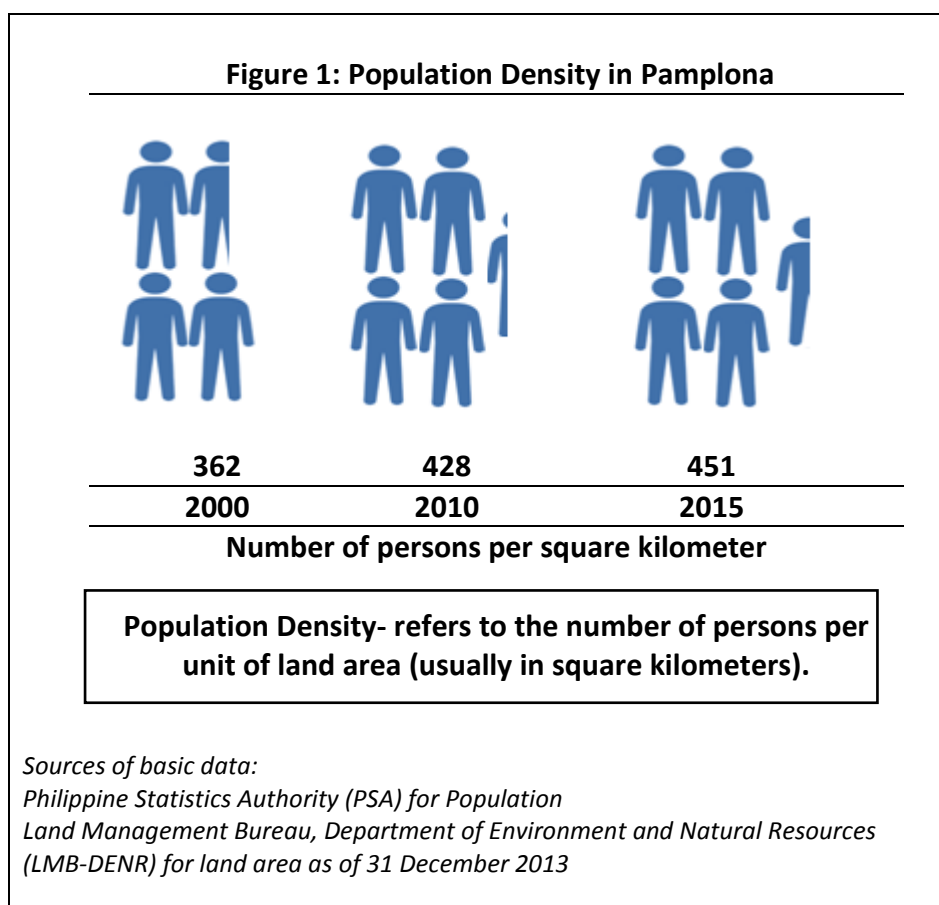

Population of the Municipality of Pamplona (Based on the Results of 2015 Census of Population)

Population density in Pamplona increases from 428 to 451 persons per square kilometer

- With a total land area of approximately 80.60 square kilometers, the population density of Pamplona in 2015 was posted at 451 persons per square kilometer. This represents an increase of 23 persons per square kilometer from the population density of 428 persons per square kilometer in 2010. In 2000, there were about 362 persons residing in every square kilometer of land in the municipality.



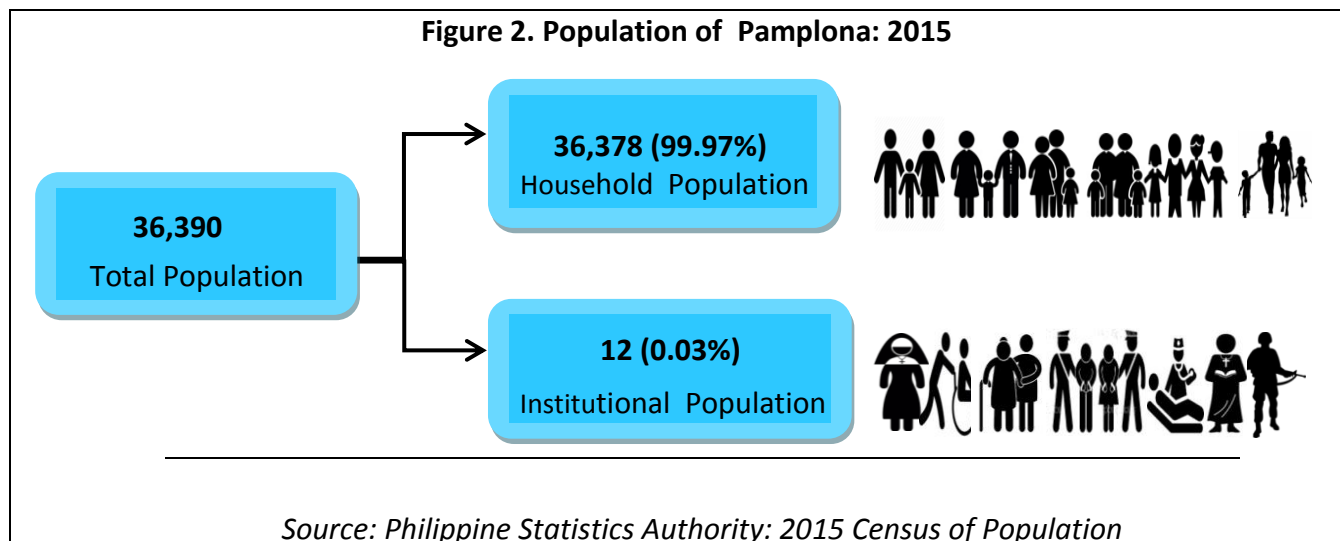
Household population comprised 99.97 percent of the total population

- The household population of Pamplona reached 36,378 persons in 2015. This is 1,907 higher than the 34,471 household population reported in 2010, and 7,209 more than the 29,169 household population posted in 2000.

- The household population comprised 99.97 percent of the total population in Pamplona, while remaining 0.03 percent comprised the institutional population or those residing in collective or institutional living quarters such as hotels, hospitals, orphanages and home for the aged, corrective and penal institutions and military camps.



Number of households increased by 744 from 6,839 in 2010 to 7,583 in 2015

- The total number of households in Pamplona in 2015 was recorded at 7,583 higher by 744 households compared with 6,839 in 2010 and higher by 2,162 compared with 5,421 in 2000.

Population of the Municipality of Pamplona (Based on the Results of 2015 Census of Population)

Average household size was 4.80 persons in 2015

- Average household size (AHS) in Pamplona decreased from 5.04 persons in 2010 to 4.80 persons in 2015. In 2000, there were 5.38 persons, on average, per household.

- From 2000 to 2015, while the household population and number of household are increasing, the average household size is decreasing.
- The reported household population of this municipality in 2015 is higher by 6 percent compared to its 2010 count. While from 2000 to 2010, its household population increased by 18 percent.
