Population of the Municipality of Pili (Capital) (Based on the Results of 2015 Census of Population)

The population of Pili (Capital) as of 2015 is 89,545

- Pili (Capital)'s population as of August 1, 2015 was 89,545, based on the 2015 Census of Population (POPCEN2015). The municipality is the fourth most populous city/municipality of Camarines Sur.
- The 2015 population is higher by 7,238 compared with the population of 82,307 in 2010, and by 22,152 compared with the population of 67,393 in 2000.

- From 2010 to 2015, the population of Pili (Capital) increased by 1.62 percent annually, on average. By comparison, the rate at which the municipality's population grew during the period 2000 to 2010 was higher at 2.02 percent.

- Pili (Capital) has 26 barangays. Barangay San Jose had the biggest population of 12,599 persons in 2015 and accounted for about 14.07 percent of the municipality's population. It was followed by Barangay Palestina with 6,096, and Barangay Caroyroyan with 5,855 persons. The combined population of these three barangays accounted for about 27.42 percent of the population of Pili (Capital) in 2015.
- Barangay Santo Niño was the smallest barangay in 2015, in terms of population size, with 1,044 persons. It was followed by Barangay Old San Roque (Pob.) with 1,342 persons.

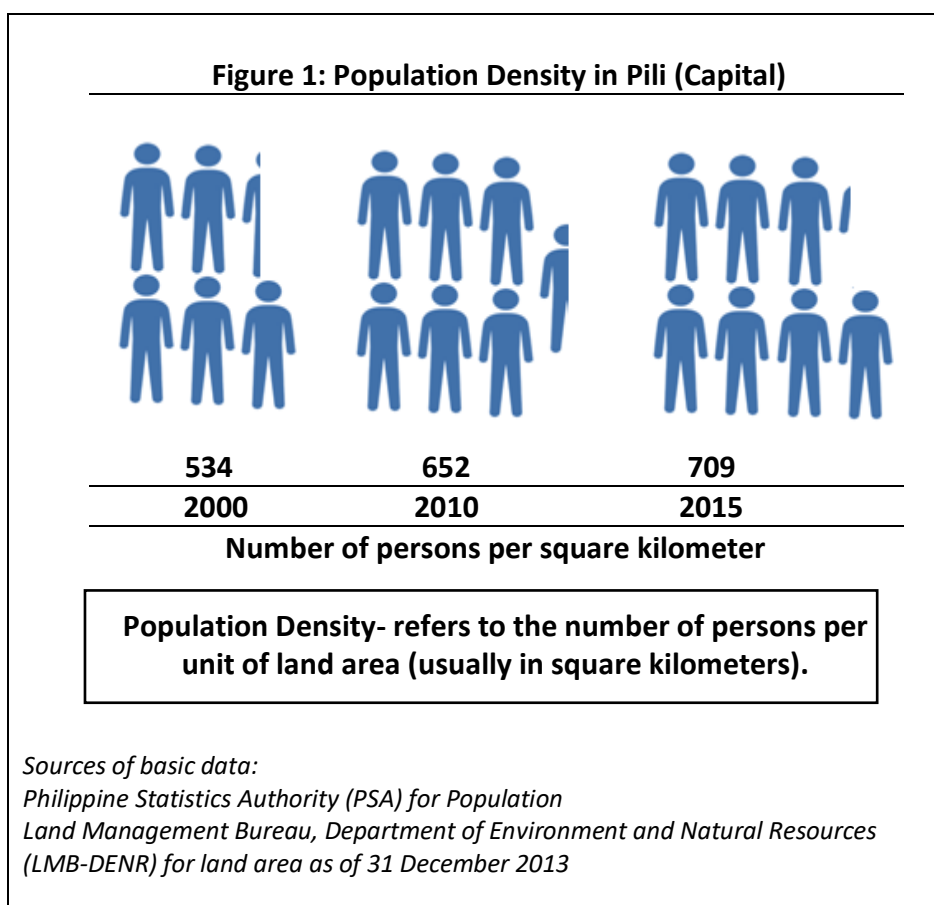

Population density in Pili (Capital) increases from 652 to 709 persons per square kilometer

- With a total land area of approximately 126.25 square kilometers, the population density of Pili (Capital) in 2015 was posted at 709 persons per square kilometer. This represents an increase of 57 persons per square kilometer from the population density of 652 persons per square kilometer in 2010. In 2000, there were about 534 persons residing in every square kilometer of land in the municipality.



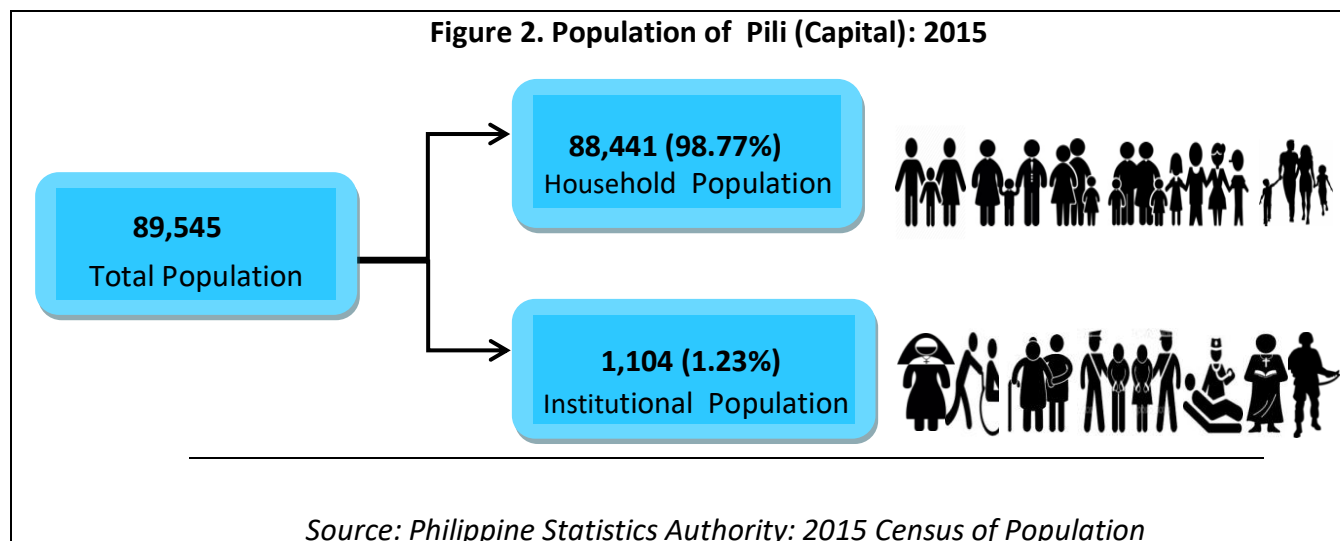
Household population comprised 98.77 percent of the total population

- The household population of Pili (Capital) reached 88,441 persons in 2015. This is 7,124 higher than the 81,317 household population reported in 2010, and 21,820 more than the 66,621 household population posted in 2000.

- The household population comprised 98.77 percent of the total population in Pili (Capital), while remaining 1.23 percent comprised the institutional population or those residing in collective or institutional living quarters such as hotels, hospitals, orphanages and home for the aged, corrective and penal institutions and military camps.



Number of households increased by 1,985 from 16,193 in 2010 to 18,178 in 2015

- The total number of households in Pili (Capital) in 2015 was recorded at 18,178 higher by 1,985 households compared with 16,193 in 2010 and higher by 5,789 compared with 12,389 in 2000.

Population of the Municipality of Pili (Capital)

(Based on the Results of 2015 Census of Population)

Average household size was 4.87 persons in 2015

- Average household size (AHS) in Pili (Capital) decreased from 5.02 persons in 2010 to 4.87 persons in 2015. In 2000, there were 5.38 persons, on average, per household.

- From 2000 to 2015, while the household population and number of household are increasing, the average household size is decreasing.
- The reported household population of this municipality in 2015 is higher by 9 percent compared to its 2010 count. While from 2000 to 2010, its household population increased by 22 percent.
