2015 Population

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Population of the Municipality of San Jose (Based on the Results of 2015 Census of Population)

The population of San Jose as of 2015 is 40,623

- San Jose's population as of August 1, 2015 was 40,623, based on the 2015 Census of Population (POPCEN2015). The municipality ranks 21st among the 37 city/municipality of Camarines Sur.
- The 2015 population is higher by 2,100 compared with the population of 38,523 in 2010, and by 8,111 compared with the population of 32,512 in 2000.

- From 2010 to 2015, the population of San Jose increased by 1.02 percent annually, on average. By comparison, the rate at which the municipality's population grew during the period 2000 to 2010 was higher at 1.71 percent.

- San Jose has 29 barangays. Barangay Salogon had the biggest population of 2,925 persons in 2015 and accounted for about 7.20 percent of the municipality's population. It was followed by Barangay Sabang with 2,858, and Barangay Calalahan with 2,531 persons. The combined population of these three barangays accounted for about 20.47 percent of the population of San Jose in 2015.
- Barangay San Vicente (Pob.) was the smallest barangay in 2015, in terms of population size, with 176 persons. It was followed by Barangay Bahay with 337 persons.

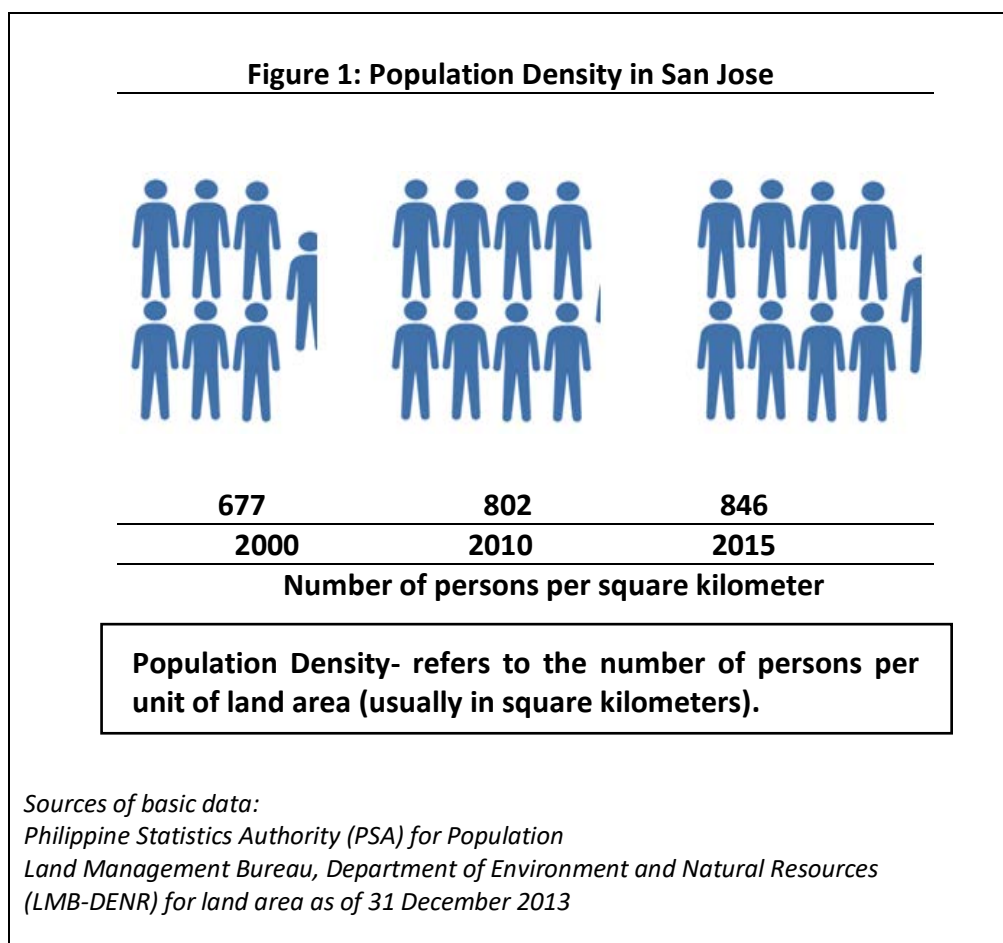

Population of the Municipality of San Jose (Based on the Results of 2015 Census of Population)

Population density in San Jose increases from 802 to 846 persons per square kilometer

- With a total land area of approximately 48.04 square kilometers, the population density of San Jose in 2015 was posted at 846 persons per square kilometer. This represents an increase of 44 persons per square kilometer from the population density of 802 persons per square kilometer in 2010. In 2000, there were about 677 persons residing in every square kilometer of land in the municipality.



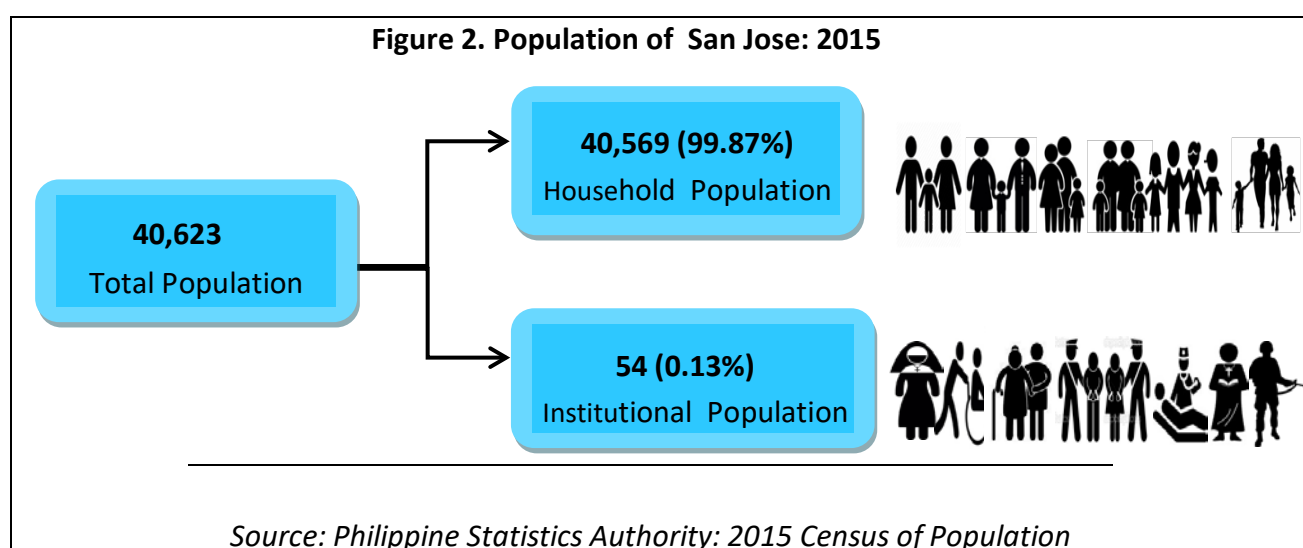
Household Population comprised 99.87 percent of the total population

- The household population of San Jose reached 40,569 persons in 2015. This is 2,054 higher than the 38,515 household population reported in 2010, and 8,074 more than the 32,495 household population posted in 2000.

- The household population comprised 99.87 percent of the total population in San Jose, while the remaining 0.13 percent comprised the institutional population or those residing in collective or institutional living quarters such as hotels, hospitals, orphanages and home for the aged, corrective and penal institutions and military camps.



Number of households increased by 997 from 7,687 in 2010 to 8,684 in 2015

- The total number of households in San Jose in 2015 was recorded at 8,684 higher by 997 households compared with 7,687 in 2010 and higher by 2,641 compared with 6,043 in 2000.

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Average household size was 4.67 persons in 2015

- Average household size (AHS) in San Jose decreased from 5.01 persons in 2010 to 4.67 persons in 2015. In 2000, there were 5.38 persons, on average, per household.

- From 2000 to 2015, while the household population and number of household are increasing, the average household size is decreasing.
- The reported household population of this municipality in 2015 is higher by 5 percent compared to its 2010 count. While from 2000 to 2010, its household population increased by 19 percent.
