### **Population of the Municipality of San Fernando (Based on the Results of 2015 Census of Population)**

*The population of San Fernando as of 2015 is 35,258*

- San Fernando's population as of August 1, 2015 was 35,258, based on the 2015 Census of Population (POPCEN2015). The municipality ranks 23rd among the 37 city/municipality of Camarines Sur.
- The 2015 population is higher by 1,977 compared with the population of 33,281 in 2010, and by 7,825 compared with the population of 27,433 in 2000.

- From 2010 to 2015, the population of San Fernando increased by 1.11 percent annually, on average. By comparison, the rate at which the municipality's population grew during the period 2000 to 2010 was higher at 1.95 percent.

- San Fernando has 22 barangays. Barangay Pamukid had the biggest population of 5,623 persons in 2015 and accounted for about 15.95 percent of the municipality's population. It was followed by Barangay Lupi with 3,077, and Barangay Beberon with 2,682 persons. The combined population of these three barangays accounted for about 32.28 percent of the population of San Fernando in 2015.
- Barangay Calascagas was the smallest barangay in 2015, in terms of population size, with 517 persons. It was followed by Barangay Tagpocol with 596 persons.

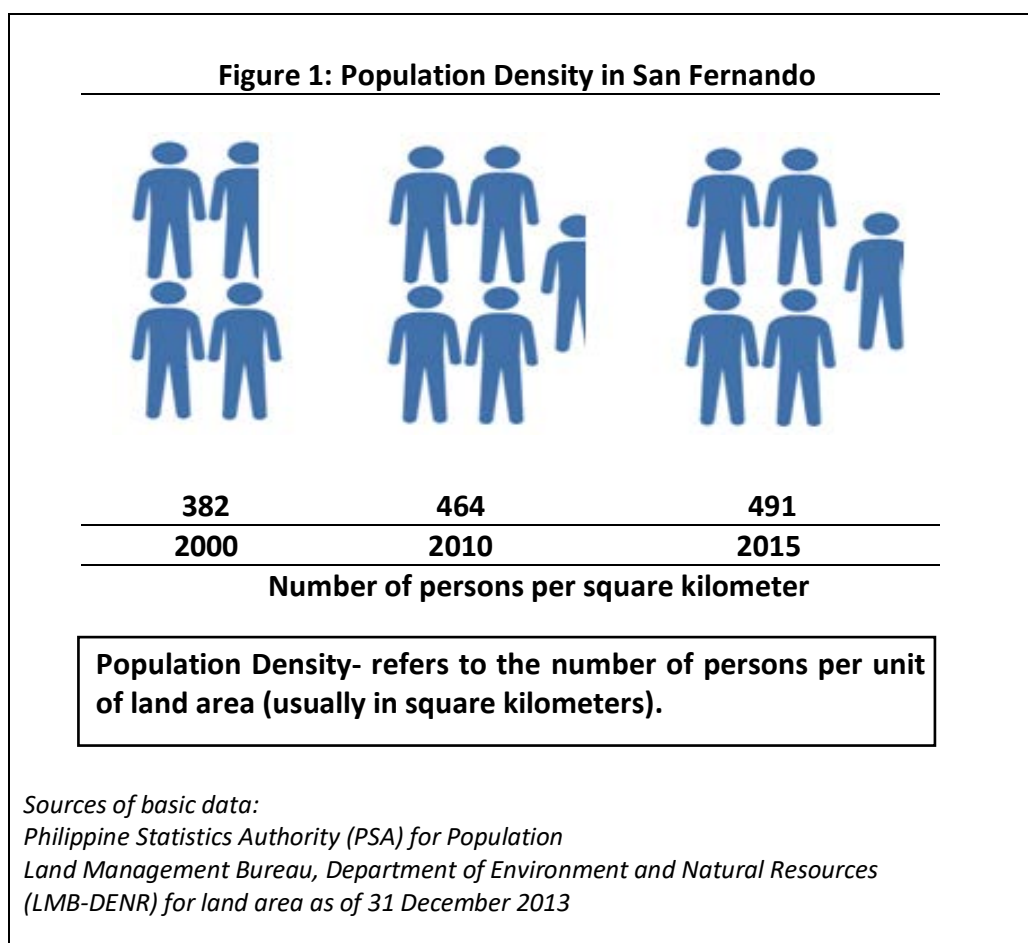

## Population of the Municipality of San Fernando (Based on the Results of 2015 Census of Population)

### **Population density in San Fernando increases from 464 to 491 persons per square kilometer**

- With a total land area of approximately 71.76 square kilometers, the population density of San Fernando in 2015 was posted at 491 persons per square kilometer. This represents an increase of 27 persons per square kilometer from the population density of 464 persons per square kilometer in 2010. In 2000, there were about 382 persons residing in every square kilometer of land in the municipality.



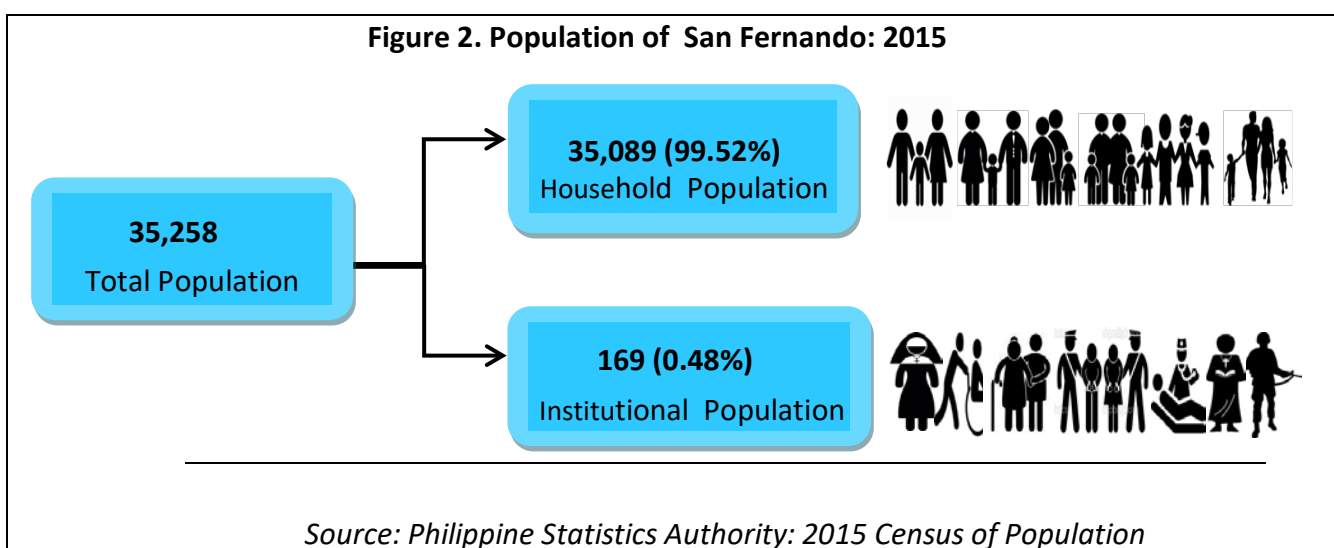
### **Household Population comprised 99.52 percent of the total population**

- The household population of San Fernando reached 35,089 persons in 2015. This is 1,822 higher than the 33,267 household population reported in 2010, and 7,658 more than the 27,431 household population posted in 2000.

- The household population comprised 99.52 percent of the total population in San Fernando, while the remaining 0.48 percent comprised the institutional population or those residing in collective or institutional living quarters such as hotels, hospitals, orphanages and home for the aged, corrective and penal institutions and military camps.



**Number of households increased by 717 from 6,529 in 2010 to 7,246 in 2015**

- The total number of households in San Fernando in 2015 was recorded at 7,246 higher by 717 households compared with 6,529 in 2010 and higher by 2,200 compared with 5,046 in 2000.

**Population of the Municipality of San Fernando**  
 (Based on the Results of 2015 Census of Population)

*Average household size was 4.84 persons in 2015*

- Average household size (AHS) in San Fernando decreased from 5.10 persons in 2010 to 4.84 persons in 2015. In 2000, there were 5.44 persons, on average, per household.

- From 2000 to 2015, while the household population and number of household are increasing, the average household size is decreasing.
- The reported household population of this municipality in 2015 is higher by 5 percent compared to its 2010 count. While from 2000 to 2010, its household population increased by 21 percent.
