HOUSING CHARACTERISTICS IN BOMBON (Results of the 2015 Census of Population)

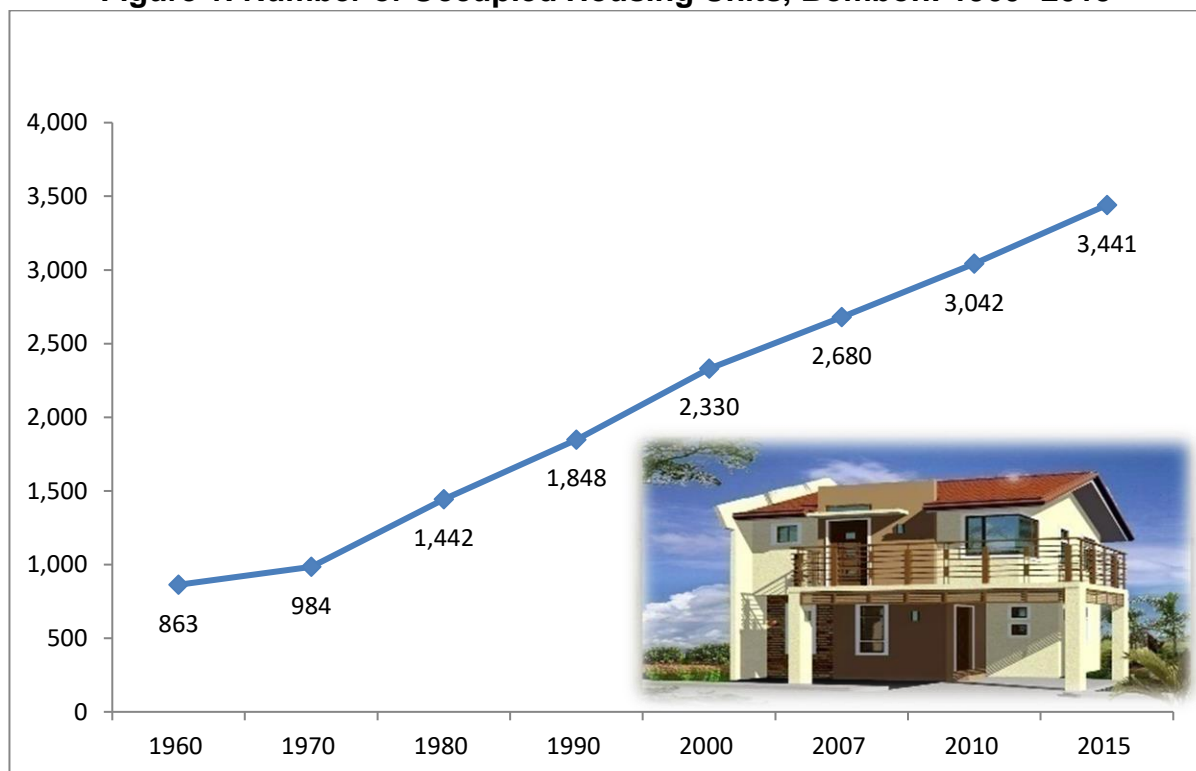
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Occupied housing units in Bombon reaches 3,441 in 2015

The number of occupied housing units in Bombon reached 3,441 in 2015, higher by 399 housing units compared with that in 2010. In 1960, there were only 863 housing units recorded. The number of housing units went up to 984 in 1970, 1,442 in 1980, 1,848 in 1990, 2,330 in 2000, 2,680 in 2007, 3,042 in 2010, and 3,441 in 2015. The number of housing units in Bombon increased by 2,578 from 1960 to 2015.

There are 101 households per 100 occupied housing units in Bombon

A total of 3,441 occupied housing units and 3,461 households were recorded in 2015. These translate to a ratio of 101 households for every 100 occupied housing units, with an average of 4.80 persons per occupied housing unit. In 2010, there were 100 households per 100 occupied housing units and an average of 5.10 persons per occupied housing unit. While in 2000, there were 100 households per 100 occupied housing units and 5.51 persons per housing unit.

Majority of the occupied housing units are single houses

In 2015, single houses made up 91.80 percent of the total occupied housing units in Bombon. About 6.80 percent of the total occupied housing units were of duplex type while 1.25 percent were multi- unit residential buildings/houses. In 2010, single houses accounted for 98.65 percent of the total occupied housing units, 0.99 percent were duplex, and 0.16 percent were multi- unit residential buildings/houses.

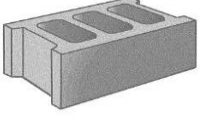

More occupied housing units with outer walls made of strong materials in 2015

There were more occupied housing units with outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone in 2015 than in 2010. In 2015, 48.33 percent of the total occupied housing units had outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone. This was higher than the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone recorded in 2010 (43.56%). On the other hand, the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of half concrete/brick/stone and half wood decreased from 11.74 percent in 2010 to 8.63 percent in 2015. Similarly, the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of wood decreased from 14.46 percent in 2010 to 7.29 percent in 2015.

Occupied housing units with roofs made of strong materials increase in 2015

The proportion of occupied housing units with roofs made of galvanized iron/aluminum increased in 2015. More than 61.49 percent of the occupied housing units in 2015 had roofs made of galvanized iron/aluminum, which is higher than the proportion of 57.96 percent recorded in 2010. The proportion of occupied housing units with roofs made of bamboo/cogon/nipa/anahaw also increased from 32.41 percent in 2010 to 34.50 percent in 2015.

Most households live in housing units they owned or with owner-like possession of house and lot

Of the 3,461 households in Bombon in 2015, 41.61 percent lived in a housing unit they owned or with owner-like possession of house and lot. Moreover, 40.51 percent of the households lived in their own housing unit and occupied lot for free but with consent of the owner. In addition, 9.62 percent of the total households lived in rent-free house and lot with consent of owner.

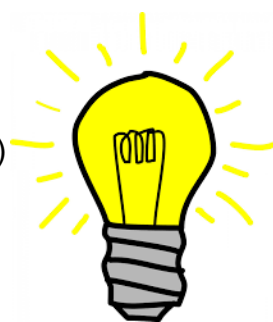

Most of the households in Bombon use electricity as fuel for lighting

Majority (91.16%) of the households in Bombon in 2015 used electricity as fuel for lighting, while kerosene (gaas) ranked second with 268 households using kerosene (gaas) as their source of fuel for lighting in 2015. Meanwhile, 1.11 percent of the total households in Bombon used either LPG, oil, solar panel, solar lamp or other source as their fuel for lighting.

Own use faucet community water system is the main source of water supply for drinking in Bombon

Own use faucet community water system was listed as the main source of water supply for drinking in Bombon in 2015. Of the 3,461 households, 1,334 households drew water supply for drinking in their own use faucet community water system while about 796 households drew water supply for drinking from shared faucet community water system. Shared tubed/piped deep well was listed as the third main source of water supply for drinking for 615 households.

1,627 households in Bombon reported own use faucet community water system as the main source of water supply for cooking

Own use faucet community water system was reported as the main source of water supply for cooking in Bombon in 2015. Around 1,627 households used own use faucet community water system as the main source of water supply for cooking. Shared faucet community water system ranked second as the main source of water supply for cooking while shared tubed/piped deep well ranked third.
