## HOUSING CHARACTERISTICS IN CALABANGA (Results of the 2015 Census of Population)

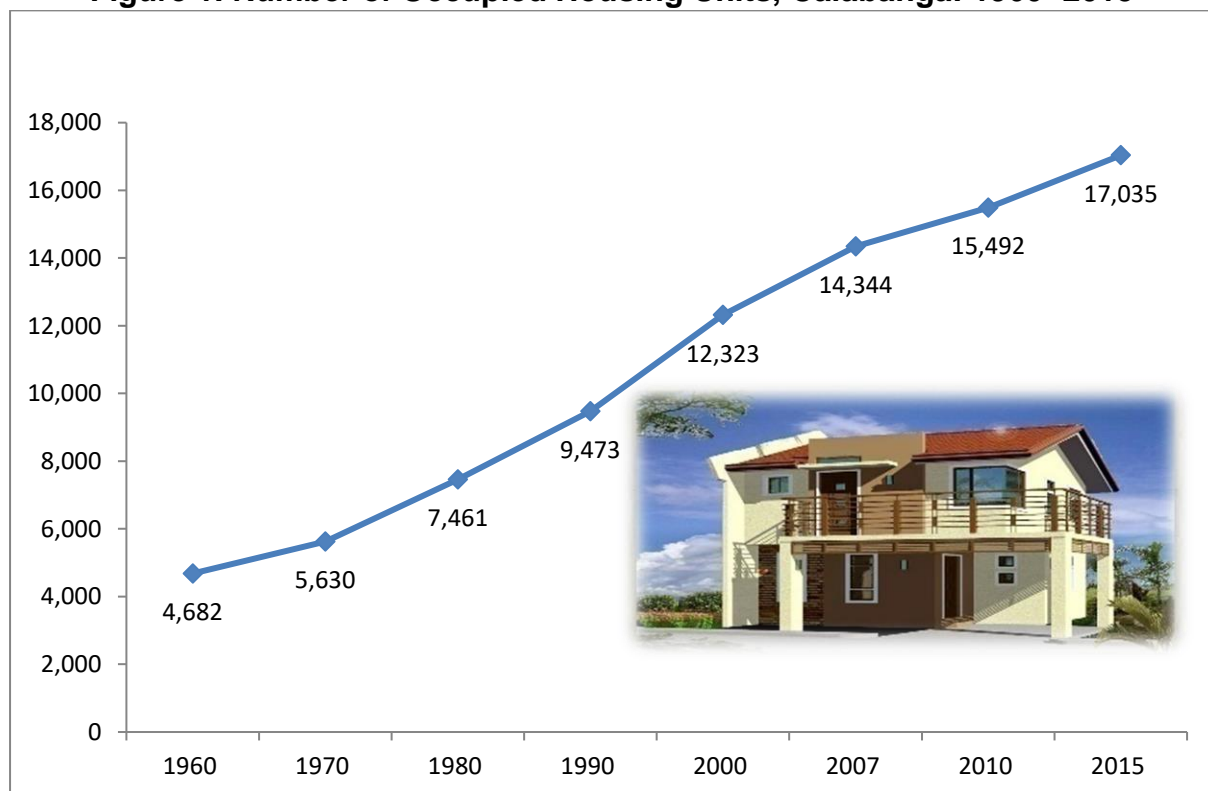
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### Occupied housing units in Calabanga reaches 17,035 in 2015

The number of occupied housing units in Calabanga reached 17,035 in 2015, higher by 1,543 housing units compared with that in 2010. In 1960, there were only 4,682 housing units recorded. The number of housing units went up to 5,630 in 1970, 7,461 in 1980, 9,473 in 1990, 12,323 in 2000, 14,344 in 2007, 15,492 in 2010, and 17,035 in 2015. The number of housing units in Calabanga increased by 12,353 from 1960 to 2015.

## There are 101 households per 100 occupied housing units in Calabanga

A total of 17,035 occupied housing units and 17,211 households were recorded in 2015. These translate to a ratio of 101 households for every 100 occupied housing units, with an average of 4.87 persons per occupied housing unit. In 2010, there were 100 households per 100 occupied housing units and an average of 5.00 persons per occupied housing unit. While in 2000, there were 101 households per 100 occupied housing units and 5.47 persons per housing unit.

## Majority of the occupied housing units are single houses

In 2015, single houses made up 94.90 percent of the total occupied housing units in Calabanga. About 3.46 percent of the total occupied housing units were of duplex type while 1.30 percent were multi- unit residential buildings/houses. In 2010, single houses accounted for 94.71 percent of the total occupied housing units, 2.81 percent were duplex, and 1.49 percent were multi- unit residential buildings/houses.



### Occupied housing units with outer walls made of strong materials decrease in 2015

There were lesser occupied housing units with outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone in 2015 than in 2010. In 2015, 40.51 percent of the total occupied housing units had outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone. This was lower than the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone recorded in 2010 (42.75%). On the other hand, the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of half concrete/brick/stone and half wood increased from 11.42 percent in 2010 to 15.07 percent in 2015. The proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of wood, decreased from 12.62 percent in 2010 to 10.17 percent in 2015.

## Occupied housing units with roofs made of strong materials decrease in 2015

The proportion of occupied housing units with roofs made of galvanized iron/aluminum decreased in 2015. About 49.23 percent of the occupied housing units in 2015 had roofs made of galvanized iron/aluminum, which is lower than the proportion of 58.51 percent recorded in 2010. The proportion of occupied housing units with roofs made of bamboo/cogon/nipa/anahaw, increased from 37.12 percent in 2010 to 40.06 percent in 2015.

## Most households live in housing units they owned or with owner-like possession of house and lot

Of the 17,211 households in Calabanga in 2015, 43.33 percent lived in a housing unit they owned or with owner-like possession of house and lot. Moreover, 42.14 percent of the households lived in their own housing unit and occupied lot for free but with consent of the owner. In addition, 5.50 percent of the total households lived in rent-free house and lot with consent of owner.

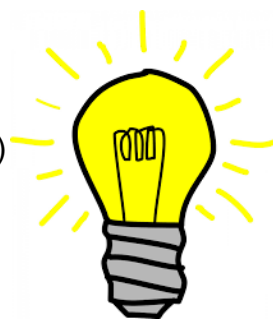

### Majority of the households in Calabanga use electricity as fuel for lighting

Majority (86.22%) of the households in Calabanga in 2015 used electricity as fuel for lighting, while kerosene (gaas) ranked second with 2,273 households using kerosene (gaas) as their source of fuel for lighting in 2015. Meanwhile, 0.58 percent of the total households in Calabanga used either LPG, oil, solar panel, solar lamp or other source as their fuel for lighting.

**Own use faucet community water system is the main source of water supply for drinking in Calabanga**

Own use faucet community water system was listed as the main source of water supply for drinking in Calabanga in 2015. Of the 17,211 households, 5,155 households drew water supply for drinking in own use faucet community water system while about 4,567 households drew water supply for drinking from shared faucet community water system. Shared tubed/piped deep well was listed as the third main source of water supply for drinking for 2,064 households. About a thousand household reported protected spring as their main source of drinking water.

**5,911 households in Calabanga reported own use faucet community water system as the main source of water supply for cooking**

Own use faucet community water system was reported as the main source of water supply for cooking in Calabanga in 2015. Around 5,911 households used own use faucet community water system as the main source of water supply for cooking. Shared faucet community water system ranked second as the main source of water supply for cooking while shared tubed/piped deep well system ranked third.
