HOUSING CHARACTERISTICS IN GARCHITORENA (Results of the 2015 Census of Population)

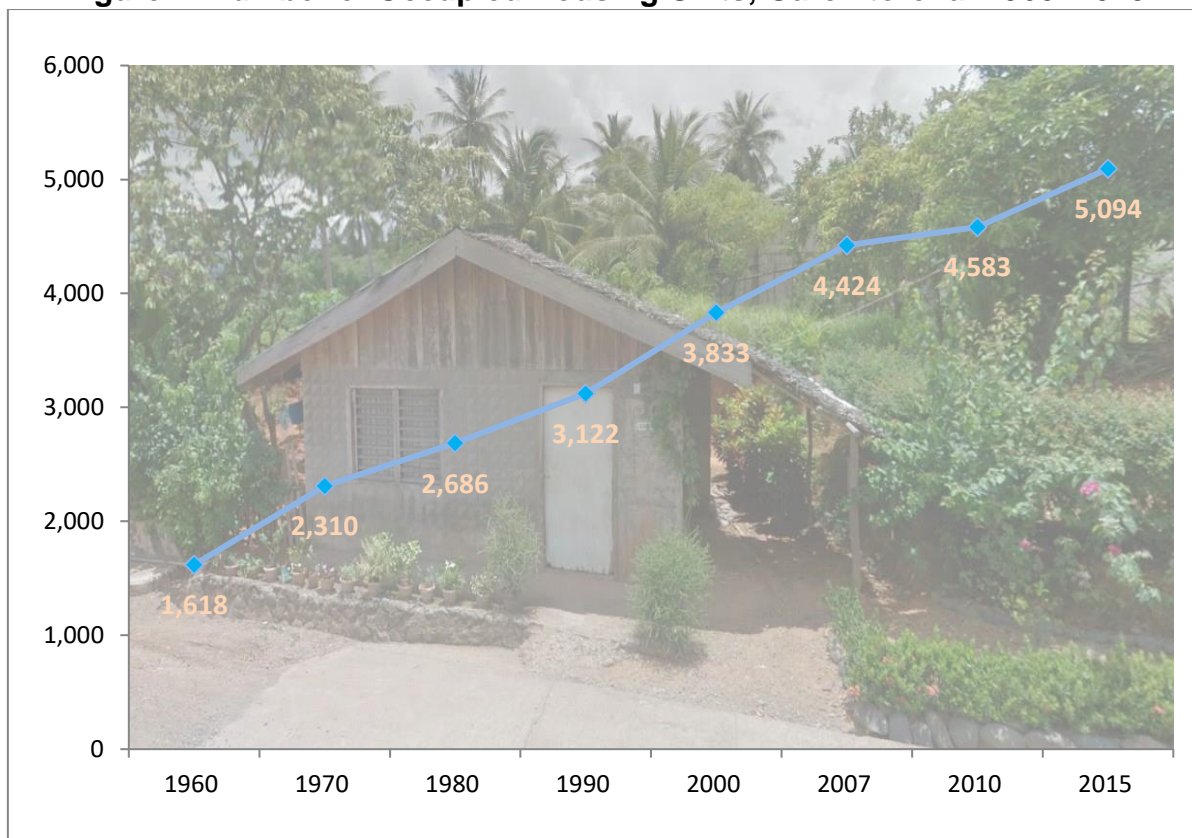

Occupied housing units in Garchitorena reaches 5,094 in 2015

The number of occupied housing units in Garchitorena reached 5,094 in 2015, higher by 511 housing units compared with that in 2010. In 1960, there were only 1,618 housing units recorded. The number of housing units went up to 2,310 in 1970, 2,686 in 1980, 3,122 in 1990, 3,833 in 2000, 4,424 in 2007, 4,583 in 2010, and 5,094 in 2015. The number of housing units in Garchitorena increased by 3,476 from 1960 to 2015.

There are 102 households per 100 occupied housing units in Garchitorena

A total of 5,094 occupied housing units and 5,216 households were recorded in 2015 in Garchitorena. These translate to a ratio of 102 households for every 100 occupied housing units, with an average of 5.30 persons per occupied housing unit. In 2010, there were 100 households per 100 occupied housing units and an average of 5.50 persons per occupied housing unit. While in 2000, there were 101 households per 100 occupied housing units and 6.01 persons per housing unit.

Majority of the occupied housing units are single houses

In 2015, single houses made up 98.02 percent of the total occupied housing units in Garchitorena. About 1.41 percent of the total occupied housing units were of duplex type while 0.41 percent were multi- unit residential buildings/houses. In 2010, single houses accounted for 99.39 percent of the total occupied housing units, 0.24 percent were duplex, and 0.07 percent were multi- unit residential buildings/houses.



More occupied housing units with outer walls made of strong materials in 2015

There were more occupied housing units with outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone in 2015 than in 2010. In 2015, 19.85 percent of the total occupied housing units had outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone. This was higher than the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone recorded in 2010 (17.94%). On the other hand, the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of half concrete/brick/stone and half wood decreased from 15.19 percent in 2010 to 14.90 percent in 2015. The proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of wood also decreased from 33.36 percent in 2010 to 22.83 percent in 2015.

Occupied housing units with roofs made of strong materials decrease in 2015

The proportion of occupied housing units with roofs made of galvanized iron/aluminum decreased in 2015 in Garchitorena. About 15.76 percent of the occupied housing units in 2015 had roofs made of galvanized iron/aluminum, which is lower than the proportion of 22.78 percent recorded in 2010. The proportion of occupied housing units with roofs made of bamboo/cogon/nipa/anahaw increased from 69.04 percent in 2010 to 76.34 percent in 2015.

Most households live in housing units they owned or with owner-like possession of house and lot

Of the 5,216 households in Garchitorena in 2015, 59.68 percent lived in a housing unit they owned or with owner-like possession of house and lot. Moreover, 20.40 percent of the households lived in their own housing unit and occupied lot for free but with consent of the owner. In addition, 6.02 percent of the total households lived in rent-free house and lot with consent of owner.

Most of the households in Garchitorena use electricity as fuel for lighting

Majority (59.36%) of the households in Garchitorena in 2015 used electricity as fuel for lighting, while kerosene (gaas) ranked second with 1,733 households using kerosene (gaas) as their source of fuel for lighting in 2015. Meanwhile, 7.42 percent of the total households in Garchitorena used either LPG, oil, solar panel, solar lamp or other source as their fuel for lighting.

Shared faucet community water system is the main source of water supply for drinking in Garchitorena

Shared faucet community water system was listed as the main source of water supply for drinking in Garchitorena in 2015. Of the 5,216 households, 2,092 households drew water supply for drinking from shared faucet community water system while about 1,222 households drew water supply for drinking from dug well. Shared tubed/piped deep well was listed as the third main source of water supply for drinking for 939 households.

1,943 households in Garchitorena reported shared faucet community water system as the main source of water supply for cooking

Shared faucet community water system was reported as the main source of water supply for cooking in Garchitorena in 2015. Around 1,943 households used shared faucet community water system as the main source of water supply for cooking. Dug well ranked second as the main source of water supply for cooking while shared tubed/piped deep well ranked third.
