HOUSING CHARACTERISTICS IN LAGONOY (Results of the 2015 Census of Population)

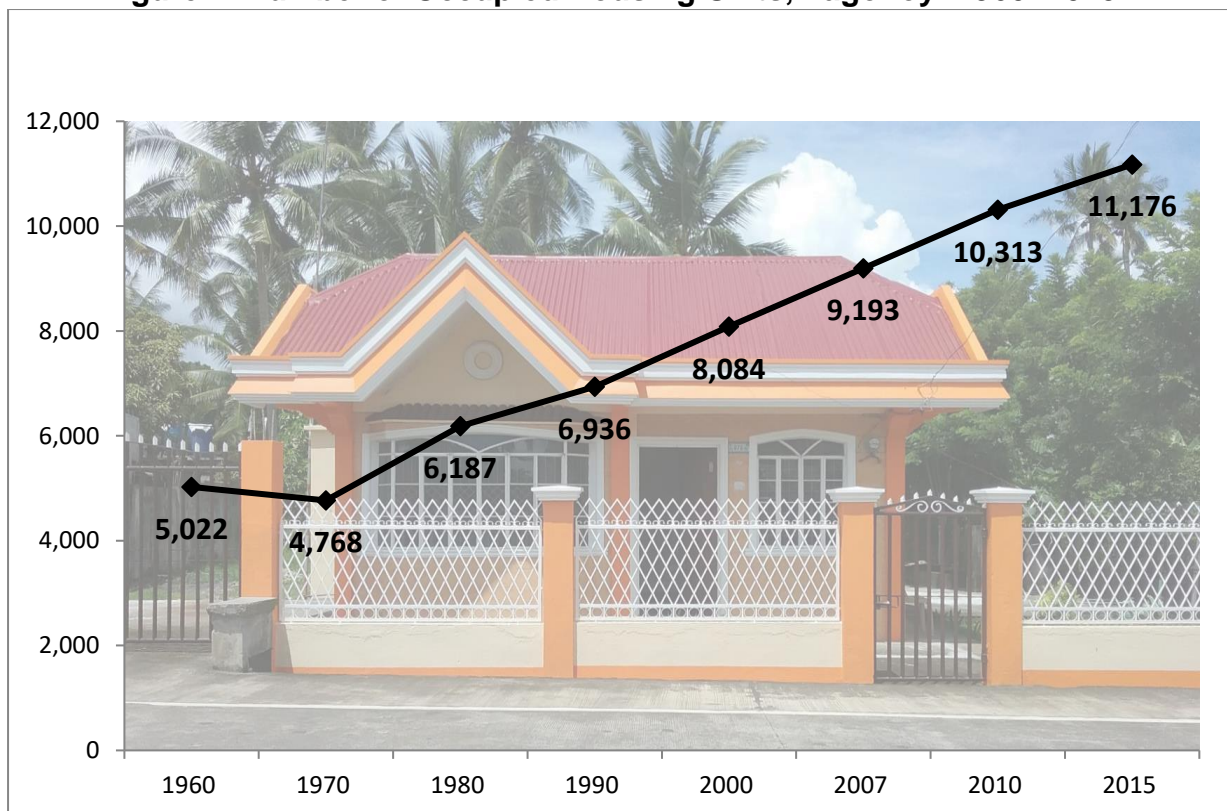

Occupied housing units in Lagonoy reaches 11,176 in 2015

The number of occupied housing units in Lagonoy reached 11,176 in 2015, higher by 863 housing units compared with that in 2010. In 1960, there were only 5,022 housing units recorded. The number of housing units went down to 4,768 in 1970, increased to 6,187 in 1980, 6,936 in 1990, 8,084 in 2000, 9,193 in 2007, 10,313 in 2010, and 11,176 in 2015. The number of housing units in Lagonoy increased by 6,154 from 1960 to 2015.

There are 101 households per 100 occupied housing units in Lagonoy

A total of 11,176 occupied housing units and 11,312 households were recorded in Lagonoy in 2015. These translate to a ratio of 101 households for every 100 occupied housing units, with an average of 4.96 persons per occupied housing unit. In 2010, there were 100 households per 100 occupied housing units and an average of 5.00 persons per occupied housing unit. While in 2000, there were 101 households per 100 occupied housing units and 5.27 persons per housing unit.

Majority of the occupied housing units are single houses

In 2015, single houses made up 95.37 percent of the total occupied housing units in Lagonoy. About 3.72 percent of the total occupied housing units were of duplex type while 0.64 percent were multi- unit residential buildings/houses. In 2010, single houses accounted for 97.95 percent of the total occupied housing units, 1.67 percent were duplex, and 0.22 percent were multi- unit residential buildings/houses.



More occupied housing units with outer walls made of strong materials in 2015

There were more occupied housing units with outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone in 2015 than in 2010 in Lagonoy. In 2015, 39.15 percent of the total occupied housing units had outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone. This was higher than the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone recorded in 2010 (36.79%). Meanwhile, the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of half concrete/brick/stone and half wood decreased from 17.68 percent in 2010 to 16.80 percent in 2015. Similarly, the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of wood also decreased from 23.68 percent in 2010 to 21.39 percent in 2015.

Occupied housing units with roofs made of strong materials decrease in 2015

The proportion of occupied housing units with roofs made of galvanized iron/aluminum decreased in 2015 in Lagonoy. About 45.94 percent of the occupied housing units in 2015 had roofs made of galvanized iron/aluminum, which is lower than the proportion of 47.03 percent recorded in 2010. The proportion of occupied housing units with roofs made of bamboo/cogon/nipa/anhaw slightly increased from 43.36 percent in 2010 to 43.67 percent in 2015.

Most households live in housing units they owned or with owner-like possession of house and lot

Of the 11,312 households in Lagonoy in 2015, 59.44 percent lived in a housing unit they owned or with owner-like possession of house and lot. Moreover, 27.85 percent of the households lived in their own housing unit and occupied lot for free but with consent of the owner. In addition, 4.95 percent of the total households lived in rent-free house and lot with consent of owner.

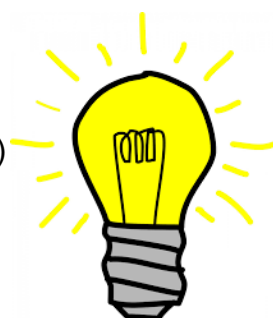

Majority of the households in Lagonoy use electricity as fuel for lighting

Majority (83.65%) of the households in Lagonoy in 2015 used electricity as fuel for lighting, while kerosene (gaas) ranked second with 1,747 households using kerosene (gaas) as their source of fuel for lighting in 2015. Meanwhile, 0.90 percent of the total households in Lagonoy used either LPG, oil, solar panel, solar lamp or other source as their fuel for lighting.

Shared tubed/piped deep well is the main source of water supply for drinking in Lagonoy

Shared tubed/piped deep well was listed as the main source of water supply for drinking in Lagonoy in 2015. Of the 11,312 households, 3,210 households drew water supply for drinking from shared tubed/piped deep well while about 3,042 households drew water supply for drinking from shared faucet community water system. Own use faucet community water system was listed as the third main source of water supply for drinking for 2,325 households.

3,328 households in Lagonoy reported shared tubed/piped deep well as the main source of water supply for cooking

Shared tubed/piped deep well was reported as the main source of water supply for cooking in Lagonoy in 2015. Around 3,328 households used shared tubed/piped deep well as the main source of water supply for cooking. Shared faucet community water system ranked second as the main source of water supply for cooking while own use faucet community water system ranked third.
