HOUSING CHARACTERISTICS IN LUPI (Results of the 2015 Census of Population)

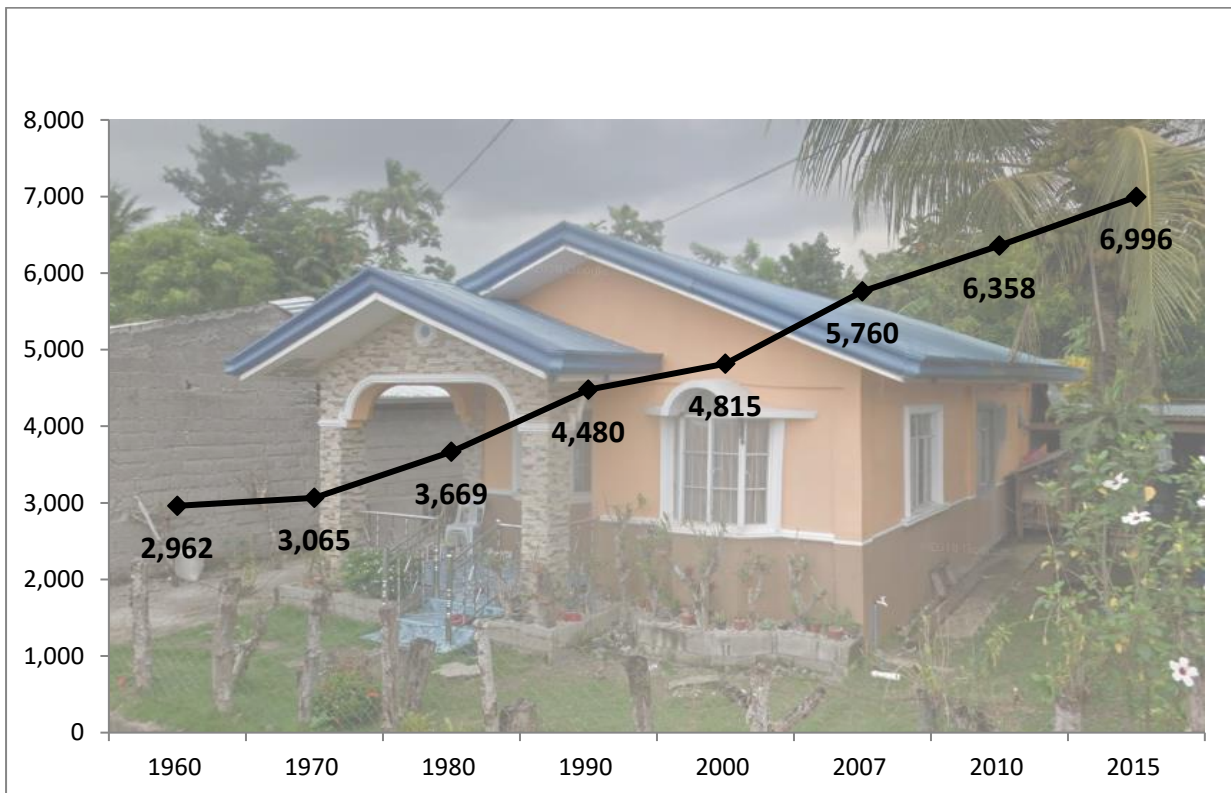
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Occupied housing units in Lupi reaches 6,996 in 2015

The number of occupied housing units in Lupi reached 6,996 in 2015, higher by 638 housing units compared with that in 2010. In 1960, there were only 2,962 housing units recorded. The number of housing units went up to 3,065 in 1970, 3,669 in 1980, 4,480 in 1990, 4,815 in 2000, 5,760 in 2007, 6,358 in 2010, and 6,996 in 2015. The number of housing units in Lupi increased by 4,034 from 1960 to 2015.

There are 100 households per 100 occupied housing units in Lupi

A total of 6,996 occupied housing units and 7,013 households were recorded in Lupi in 2015. These translate to a ratio of 100 households for every 100 occupied housing units, with an average of 4.59 persons per occupied housing unit. In 2010, there were 100 households per 100 occupied housing units and an average of 4.70 persons per occupied housing unit. While in 2000, there were 101 households per 100 occupied housing units and 5.43 persons per housing unit.

Majority of the occupied housing units are single houses

In 2015, single houses made up 97.48 percent of the total occupied housing units in Lupi. About 2.06 percent of the total occupied housing units were of duplex type while 0.36 percent were multi- unit residential buildings/houses. In 2010, single houses accounted for 98.99 percent of the total occupied housing units, 0.71 percent were duplex, and 0.19 percent were multi- unit residential buildings/houses.



More occupied housing units with outer walls made of strong materials in 2015

There were more occupied housing units with outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone in 2015 than in 2010. In 2015, 29.12 percent of the total occupied housing units had outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone. This was higher than the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone recorded in 2010 (27.56%). Similarly, the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of half concrete/brick/stone and half wood increased from 16.31 percent in 2010 to 18.57 percent in 2015. On the other hand, the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of wood decreased from 22.10 percent in 2010 to 17.97 percent in 2015.

Occupied housing units with roofs made of strong materials decrease in 2015

The proportion of occupied housing units with roofs made of galvanized iron/aluminum decreased in 2015 in Lupi. About 62.59 percent of the occupied housing units in 2015 had roofs made of galvanized iron/aluminum, which is lower than the proportion of 63.79 percent recorded in 2010. The proportion of occupied housing units with roofs made of bamboo/cogon/nipa/anahaw decreased from 31.80 percent in 2010 to 29.43 percent in 2015.

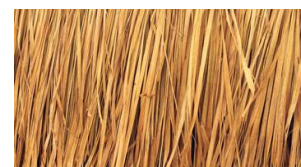

Most households live in housing units they owned or with owner-like possession of house and lot

Of the 7,013 households in Lupi in 2015, 60.16 percent lived in a housing unit they owned or with owner-like possession of house and lot. Moreover, 27.38 percent of the households lived in their own housing unit and occupied lot for free but with consent of the owner. In addition, 3.38 percent of the total households lived in rent-free house and lot with consent of owner.

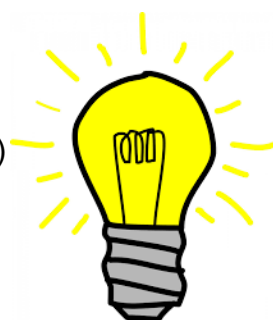

Majority of the households in Lupi use electricity as fuel for lighting

Majority (81.48%) of the households in Lupi in 2015 used electricity as fuel for lighting, while kerosene (gaas) ranked second with 1,255 households using kerosene (gaas) as their source of fuel for lighting in 2015. Meanwhile, 0.63 percent of the total households in Lupi used either LPG, oil, solar panel, solar lamp or other source as their fuel for lighting.

Own use faucet community water system is the main source of water supply for drinking in Lupi

Own use faucet community water system was listed as the main source of water supply for drinking in Lupi in 2015. Of the 7,013 households, 2,287 households drew water supply for drinking from own use faucet community water system while about 1,934 households drew water supply for drinking from shared faucet community water system. Dug well was listed as the third main source of water supply for drinking for 934 households.

2,329 households in Lupi reported own use faucet community water system as the main source of water supply for cooking

Own use faucet community water system was reported as the main source of water supply for cooking in Lupi in 2015. Around 2,329 households used own use faucet community water system as the main source of water supply for cooking. Shared faucet community water system ranked second as the main source of water supply for cooking while dug well ranked third.
