## HOUSING CHARACTERISTICS IN MAGARAO (Results of the 2015 Census of Population)

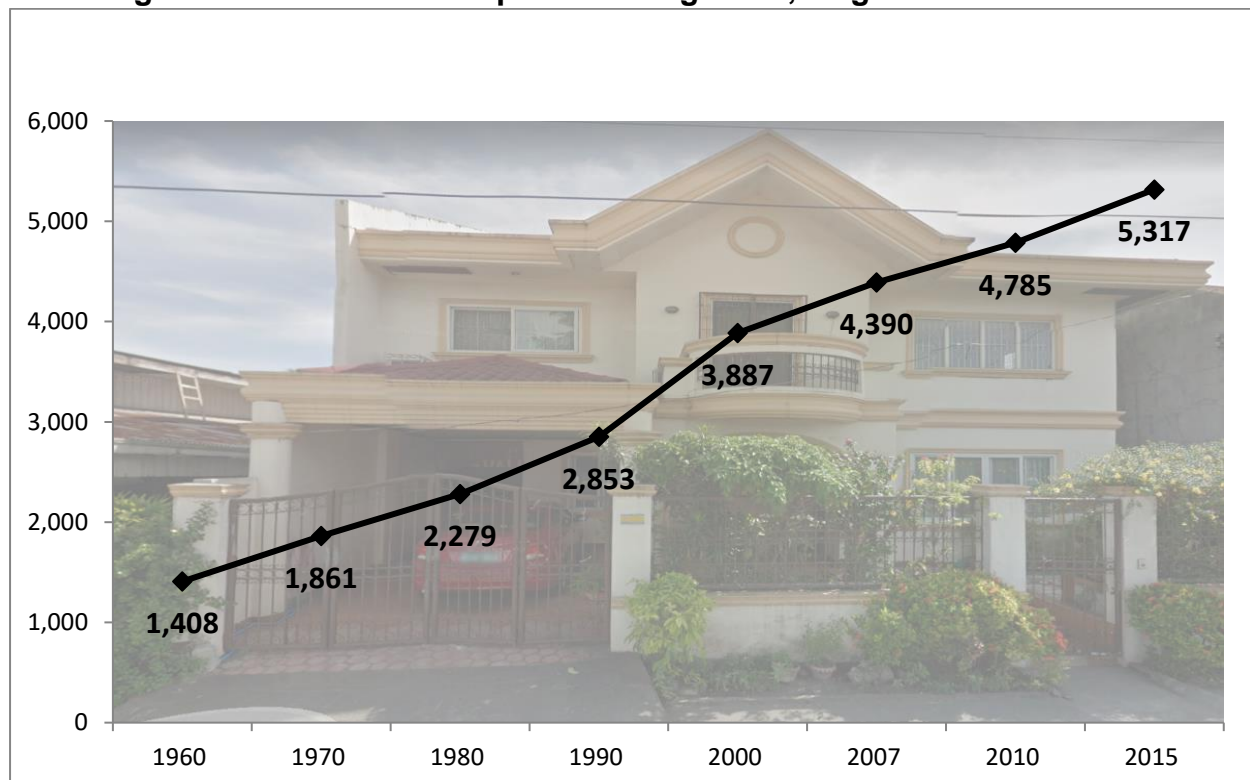

### Occupied housing units in Magarao reaches 5,317 in 2015

The number of occupied housing units in Magarao reached 5,317 in 2015, higher by 532 housing units compared with that in 2010. In 1960, there were only 1,408 housing units recorded. The number of housing units went up to 1,861 in 1970, 2,279 in 1980, 2,853 in 1990, 3,887 in 2000, 4,390 in 2007, 4,785 in 2010, and 5,317 in 2015. The number of housing units in Magarao increased by 3,909 from 1960 to 2015.

## There are 100 households per 100 occupied housing units in Magarao

A total of 5,317 occupied housing units and 5,333 households were recorded in 2015 in Magarao. These translate to a ratio of 100 households for every 100 occupied housing units, with an average of 4.83 persons per occupied housing unit. In 2010, there were 100 households per 100 occupied housing units and an average of 5.10 persons per occupied housing unit. While in 2000, there were 101 households per 100 occupied housing units and 5.39 persons per housing unit.

## Majority of the occupied housing units are single houses

In 2015, single houses made up 91.22 percent of the total occupied housing units in Magarao. About 5.08 percent of the total occupied housing units were of duplex type while 3.29 percent were multi- unit residential buildings/houses. In 2010, single houses accounted for 91.45 percent of the total occupied housing units, 5.16 percent were duplex, and 2.70 percent were multi- unit residential buildings/houses.



### More occupied housing units with outer walls made of strong materials in 2015

There were more occupied housing units with outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone in 2015 than in 2010 in Magarao. In 2015, 53.66 percent of the total occupied housing units had outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone. This was higher than the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone recorded in 2010 (48.05%). On the other hand, the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of half concrete/brick/stone and half wood decreased from 11.49 percent in 2010 to 8.18 percent in 2015. Similarly, the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of wood also decreased from 10.68 percent in 2010 to 7.69 percent in 2015.

## Occupied housing units with roofs made of strong materials decrease in 2015

The proportion of occupied housing units with roofs made of galvanized iron/aluminum decreased in 2015 in Magarao. About 60.49 percent of the occupied housing units in 2015 had roofs made of galvanized iron/aluminum, which is slightly lower than the proportion of 60.86 percent recorded in 2010. The proportion of occupied housing units with roofs made of bamboo/cogon/nipa/anahaw also decreased from 36.11 percent in 2010 to 35.70 percent in 2015.

## Most households live in housing units they owned or with owner-like possession of house and lot

Of the 5,333 households in Magarao in 2015, 48.12 percent lived in a housing unit they owned or with owner-like possession of house and lot. Moreover, 35.80 percent of the households lived in their own housing unit and occupied lot for free but with consent of the owner. In addition, 5.96 percent of the total households lived in rent-free house and lot with consent of owner.

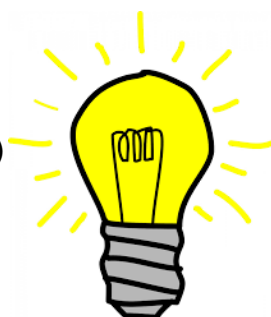

### Majority of the households in Magarao use electricity as fuel for lighting

Majority (89.69%) of the households in Magarao in 2015 used electricity as fuel for lighting, while kerosene (gaas) ranked second with 480 households using kerosene (gaas) as their source of fuel for lighting in 2015. Meanwhile, 1.31 percent of the total households in Magarao used either LPG, oil, solar panel, solar lamp or other source as their fuel for lighting.

**Own use faucet community water system is the main source of water supply for drinking in Magarao**

Own use faucet community water system was listed as the main source of water supply for drinking in Magarao in 2015. Of the 5,333 households, 1,798 households drew water supply for drinking from own use faucet community water system while about 1,444 households drew water supply for drinking from shared faucet community water system. Bottled water was listed as the third main source of water supply for drinking for 759 households.

**2,397 households in Magarao reported own use faucet community water system as the main source of water supply for cooking**

Own use faucet community water system was reported as the main source of water supply for cooking in Magarao in 2015. Around 2,397 households used own use faucet community water system as the main source of water supply for cooking. Shared faucet community water system ranked second as the main source of water supply for cooking while shared tubed/ piped deep well ranked third.
