HOUSING CHARACTERISTICS IN NABUA (Results of the 2015 Census of Population)

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Occupied housing units in Nabua reaches 16,509 in 2015

The number of occupied housing units in Nabua reached 16,509 in 2015, higher by 1,410 housing units compared with that in 2010. In 1970, there were only 6,975 housing units recorded. The number of housing units went up to 9,010 in 1980, increased to 10,307 in 1990, 12,545 in 2000, 14,301 in 2007, 15,099 in 2010, and 16,509 in 2015. The number of housing units in Nabua increased by 9,534 from 1970 to 2015.

There are 101 households per 100 occupied housing units in Nabua

A total of 16,509 occupied housing units and 16,625 households were recorded in 2015 in Nabua. These translate to a ratio of 101 households for every 100 occupied housing units, with an average of 5.07 persons per occupied housing unit. In 2010, there were 100 households per 100 occupied housing units and an average of 5.30 persons per occupied housing unit. While in 2000, there were 101 households per 100 occupied housing units and 5.65 persons per housing unit.

Majority of the occupied housing units are single houses

In 2015, single houses made up 96.95 percent of the total occupied housing units in Nabua. About 2.33 percent of the total occupied housing units were of duplex type while 0.62 percent were multi- unit residential buildings/houses. In 2010, single houses accounted for 98.34 percent of the total occupied housing units, 0.68 percent were duplex, and 0.52 percent were multi- unit residential buildings/houses.



More occupied housing units with outer walls made of strong materials in 2015

There were more occupied housing units with outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone in 2015 than in 2010 in Nabua. In 2015, 50.60 percent of the total occupied housing units had outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone. This was higher than the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone recorded in 2010 (48.76%). Similarly, the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of half concrete/brick/stone and half wood increased from 14.84 percent in 2010 to 17.63 percent in 2015. On the other hand, the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of wood decreased from 5.85 percent in 2010 to 4.90 percent in 2015.

Occupied housing units with roofs made of strong materials decrease in 2015

The proportion of occupied housing units with roofs made of galvanized iron/aluminum decreased in 2015 in Nabua. About 55.39 percent of the occupied housing units in 2015 had roofs made of galvanized iron/aluminum. This is lower than the proportion of 57.02 percent recorded in 2010. The proportion of occupied housing units with roofs made of bamboo/cogon/nipa/anhaw slightly increased from 31.68 percent in 2010 to 31.81 percent in 2015.

Most households live in housing units they owned or with owner-like possession of house and lot

Of the 16,625 households in Nabua in 2015, 75.14 percent lived in a housing unit they owned or with owner-like possession of house and lot. Moreover, 14.75 percent of the households lived in their own housing unit and occupied lot for free but with consent of the owner. In addition, 6.95 percent of the total households lived in rent-free house and lot with consent of owner.

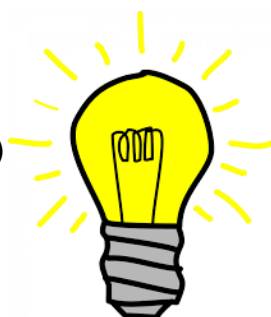

Majority of the households in Nabua use electricity as fuel for lighting

Majority (93.42%) of the households in Nabua in 2015 used electricity as fuel for lighting, while kerosene (gaas) ranked second with 1,028 households using kerosene (gaas) as their source of fuel for lighting in 2015. Meanwhile, 0.40 percent of the total households in Nabua used either LPG, oil, solar panel, solar lamp or other source as their fuel for lighting.

Own use tubed/piped deep well is the main source of water supply for drinking in Nabua

Own use tubed/piped deep well was listed as the main source of water supply for drinking in Nabua in 2015. Of the 16,625 households, 3,950 households drew water supply for drinking from own use tubed/piped deep well while about 3,934 households drew water supply for drinking from own use faucet community water system. Shared tubed/piped deep well was listed as the third main source of water supply for drinking for 3,719 households.

5,380 households in Nabua reported own use tubed/piped deep well as the main source of water supply for cooking

Own use tubed/piped deep well was reported as the main source of water supply for cooking in Nabua in 2015. Around 5,380 households used own use tubed/piped deep well as the main source of water supply for cooking. Own use faucet community water system ranked second as the main source of water supply for cooking while shared tubed/piped deep well ranked third.
