HOUSING CHARACTERISTICS IN OCAMPO (Results of the 2015 Census of Population)

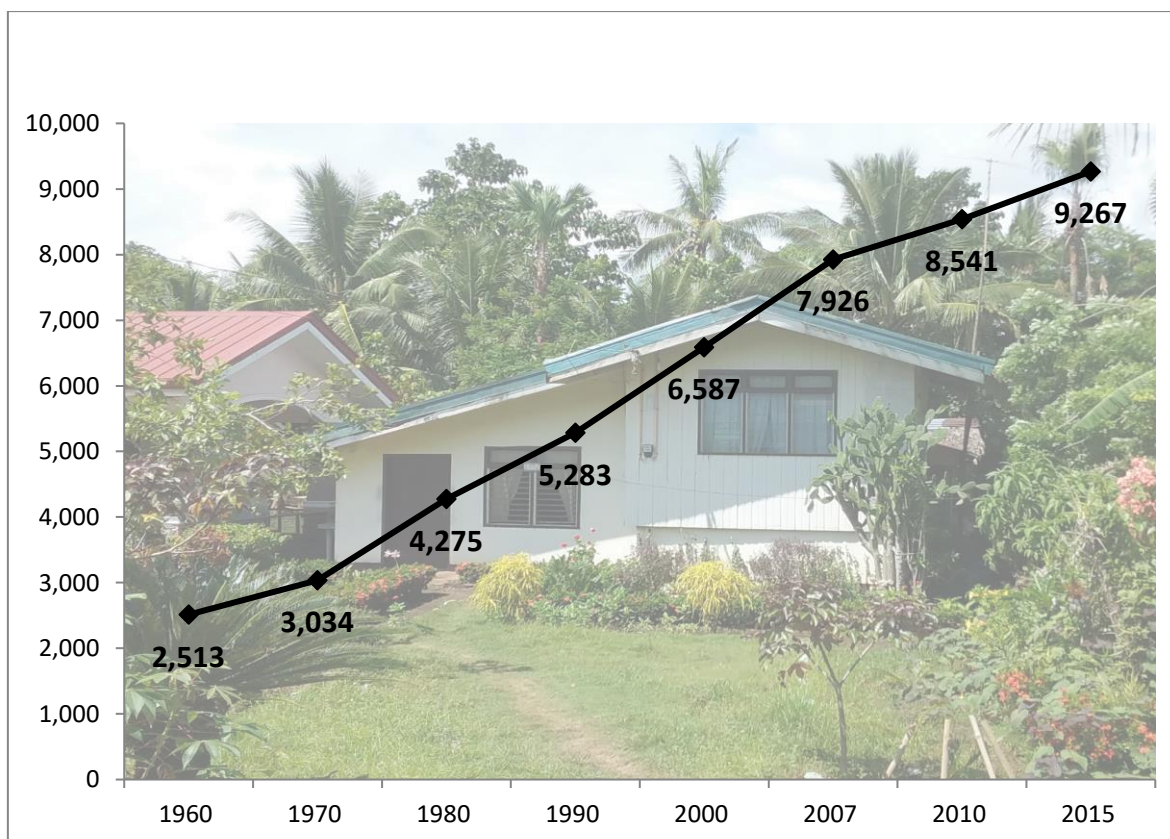
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Occupied housing units in Ocampo reaches 9,267 in 2015

The number of occupied housing units in Ocampo reached 9,267 in 2015, higher by 726 housing units compared with that in 2010. In 1960, there were only 2,513 housing units recorded. The number of housing units went up to 3,034 in 1970, 4,275 in 1980, 5,283 in 1990, 6,587 in 2000, 7,926 in 2007, 8,541 in 2010, and 9,267 in 2015. The number of housing units in Ocampo increased by 6,754 from 1960 to 2015.

There are 101 households per 100 occupied housing units in Ocampo

A total of 9,267 occupied housing units and 9,322 households were recorded in 2015 in Ocampo. These translate to a ratio of 101 households for every 100 occupied housing units, with an average of 4.96 persons per occupied housing unit. In 2010, there were 100 households per 100 occupied housing units and an average of 5.10 persons per occupied housing unit. While in 2000, there were 100 households per 100 occupied housing units and 5.51 persons per housing unit.

Majority of the occupied housing units are single houses

In 2015, single houses made up 96.85 percent of the total occupied housing units in Ocampo. About 2.18 percent of the total occupied housing units were of duplex type while 0.63 percent were multi- unit residential buildings/houses. In 2010, single houses accounted for 97.51 percent of the total occupied housing units, 1.07 percent were duplex, and 0.95 percent were multi- unit residential buildings/houses.



More occupied housing units with outer walls made of strong materials in 2015

There were more occupied housing units with outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone in 2015 than in 2010 in Ocampo. In 2015, 37.93 percent of the total occupied housing units had outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone. This was slightly higher than the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone recorded in 2010 (37.57%). On the other hand, the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of half concrete/brick/stone and half wood decreased from 13.58 percent in 2010 to 11.96 percent in 2015. Similarly, the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of wood decreased from 6.76 percent in 2010 to 5.46 percent in 2015.

Occupied housing units with roofs made of strong materials decrease in 2015

The proportion of occupied housing units with roofs made of galvanized iron/aluminum decreased in 2015 in Ocampo. About 53.18 percent of the occupied housing units in 2015 had roofs made of galvanized iron/aluminum, which is lower than the proportion of 67.08 percent recorded in 2010. The proportion of occupied housing units with roofs made of bamboo/cogon/nipa/anahaw increased from 27.98 percent in 2010 to 35.28 percent in 2015.

Most households live in housing units they owned or with owner-like possession of house and lot

Of the 9,322 households in Ocampo in 2015, 45.72 percent lived in a housing unit they owned or with owner-like possession of house and lot. Moreover, 40.66 percent of the households lived in their own housing unit and occupied lot for free but with consent of the owner. In addition, 7.93 percent of the total households lived in rent-free house and lot with consent of owner.

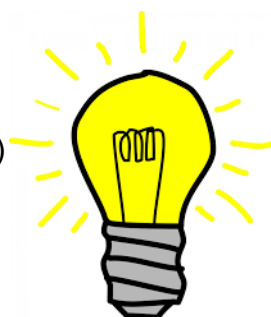

Majority of the households in Ocampo use electricity as fuel for lighting

Majority (80.37%) of the households in Ocampo in 2015 used electricity as fuel for lighting, while kerosene (gaas) ranked second with 1,759 households using kerosene (gaas) as their source of fuel for lighting in 2015. Meanwhile, 0.76 percent of the total households in Ocampo used either LPG, oil, solar panel, solar lamp or other source as their fuel for lighting.

Shared tubed/piped deep well is the main source of water supply for drinking in Ocampo

Shared tubed/piped deep well was listed as the main source of water supply for drinking in Ocampo in 2015. Of the 9,322 households, 4,612 households drew water supply for drinking from shared tubed/piped deep well while about 1,911 households drew water supply for drinking from own use tubed/piped deep well. Own use faucet community water system was listed as the third main source of water supply for drinking for 868 households.

4,365 households in Ocampo reported shared tubed/piped deep well as the main source of water supply for cooking

Shared tubed/piped deep well was reported as the main source of water supply for cooking in Ocampo in 2015. Around 4,365 households used shared tubed/piped deep well as the main source of water supply for cooking. Own use tubed/piped deep well ranked second as the main source of water supply for cooking while own use faucet community water system ranked third.
