HOUSING CHARACTERISTICS IN PASACAO (Results of the 2015 Census of Population)

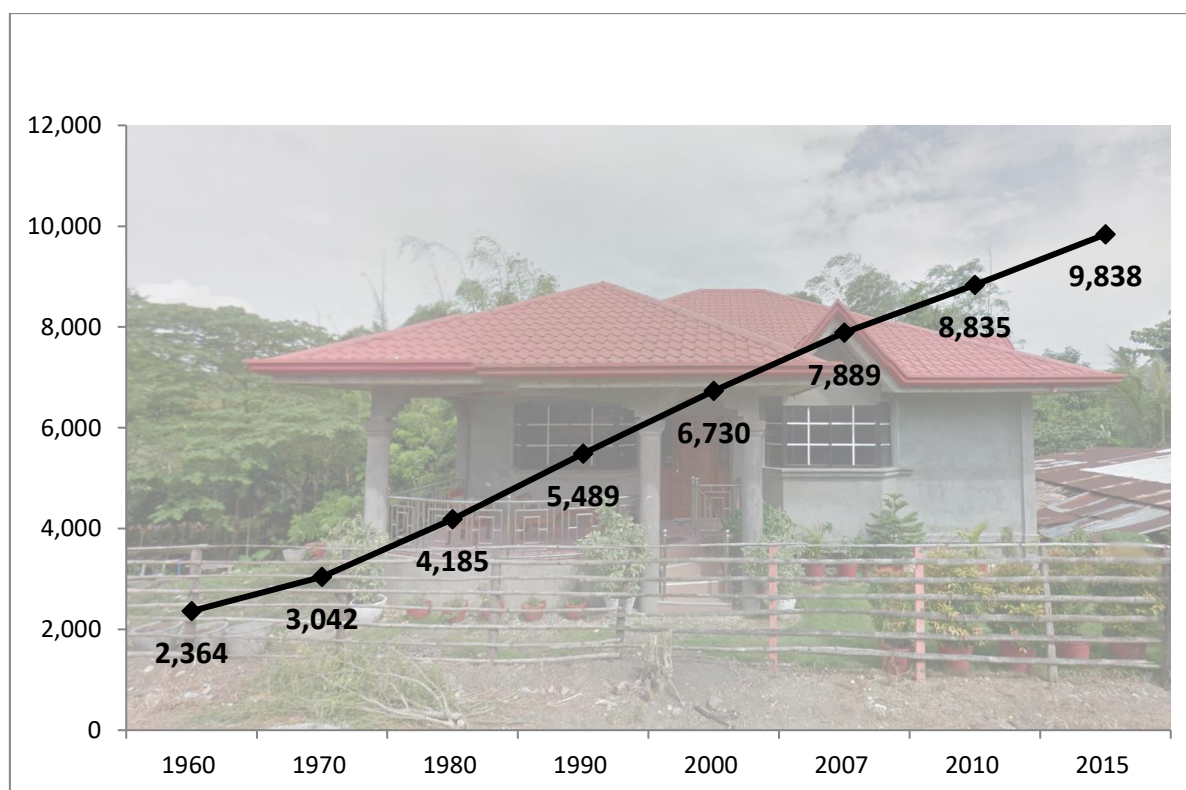

Occupied housing units in Pasacao reaches 9,838 in 2015

The number of occupied housing units in Pasacao reached 9,838 in 2015, higher by 1,003 housing units compared with that in 2010. In 1960, there were only 2,364 housing units recorded. The number of housing units went up to 3,042 in 1970, 4,185 in 1980, 5,489 in 1990, 6,730 in 2000, 7,889 in 2007, 8,835 in 2010, and 9,838 in 2015. The number of housing units in Pasacao increased by 7,474 from 1960 to 2015.

There are 101 households per 100 occupied housing units in Pasacao

A total of 9,838 occupied housing units and 9,948 households were recorded in 2015 in Pasacao. These translate to a ratio of 101 households for every 100 occupied housing units, with an average of 4.98 persons per occupied housing unit. In 2010, there were 100 households per 100 occupied housing units and an average of 5.20 persons per occupied housing unit. While in 2000, there were 101 households per 100 occupied housing units and 5.71 persons per housing unit.

Majority of the occupied housing units are single houses

In 2015, single houses made up 91.87 percent of the total occupied housing units in Pasacao. About 5.88 percent of the total occupied housing units were of duplex type while 1.59 percent were multi- unit residential buildings/houses. In 2010, single houses accounted for 96.85 percent of the total occupied housing units, 1.73 percent were duplex, and 0.66 percent were multi- unit residential buildings/houses.





More occupied housing units with outer walls made of strong materials in 2015

There were more occupied housing units with outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone in 2015 than in 2010 in Pasacao. In 2015, 36.56 percent of the total occupied housing units had outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone. This was higher than the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone recorded in 2010 (34.35%). Similarly, the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of half concrete/brick/stone and half wood increased from 10.30 percent in 2010 to 11.22 percent in 2015. Also, the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of wood increased from 18.61 percent in 2010 to 20.50 percent in 2015.

Occupied housing units with roofs made of strong materials decrease in 2015

The proportion of occupied housing units with roofs made of galvanized iron/aluminum decreased in 2015 in Pasacao. About 41.18 percent of the occupied housing units in 2015 had roofs made of galvanized iron/aluminum, which is lower than the proportion of 46.56 percent recorded in 2010. The proportion of occupied housing units with roofs made of bamboo/cogon/nipa/anahaw increased from 49.76 percent in 2010 to 50.63 percent in 2015.

Most households live in housing units they owned or with owner-like possession of house and lot

Of the 9,948 households in Pasacao in 2015, 42.62 percent lived in a housing unit they owned or with owner-like possession of house and lot. Moreover, 40.76 percent of the households lived in their own housing unit and occupied lot for free but with consent of the owner. In addition, 8.04 percent of the total households lived in rent-free house and lot with consent of owner.

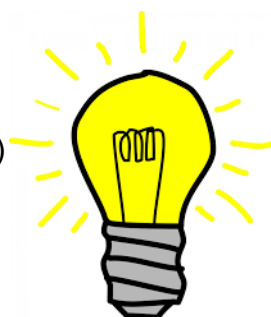

Majority of the households in Pasacao use electricity as fuel for lighting

Majority (85.60%) of the households in Pasacao in 2015 used electricity as fuel for lighting, while kerosene (gaas) ranked second with 1,344 households using kerosene (gaas) as their source of fuel for lighting in 2015. Meanwhile, 0.89 percent of the total households in Pasacao used either LPG, oil, solar panel, solar lamp or other source as their fuel for lighting.

Shared faucet community water system is the main source of water supply for drinking in Pasacao

Shared faucet community water system was listed as the main source of water supply for drinking in Pasacao in 2015. Of the 9,948 households, 2,857 households drew water supply for drinking from shared faucet community water system while about 1,819 households drew water supply for drinking from shared tubed/piped deep well. Bottled water was listed as the third main source of water supply for drinking for 1,407 households.

2,777 households in Pasacao reported shared faucet community water system as the main source of water supply for cooking

Shared faucet community water system was reported as the main source of water supply for cooking in Pasacao in 2015. Around 2,777 households used shared faucet community water system as the main source of water supply for cooking. Shared tubes/piped deep well ranked second as the main source of water supply for cooking while own use faucet community water system ranked third.
