## HOUSING CHARACTERISTICS IN RAGAY (Results of the 2015 Census of Population)

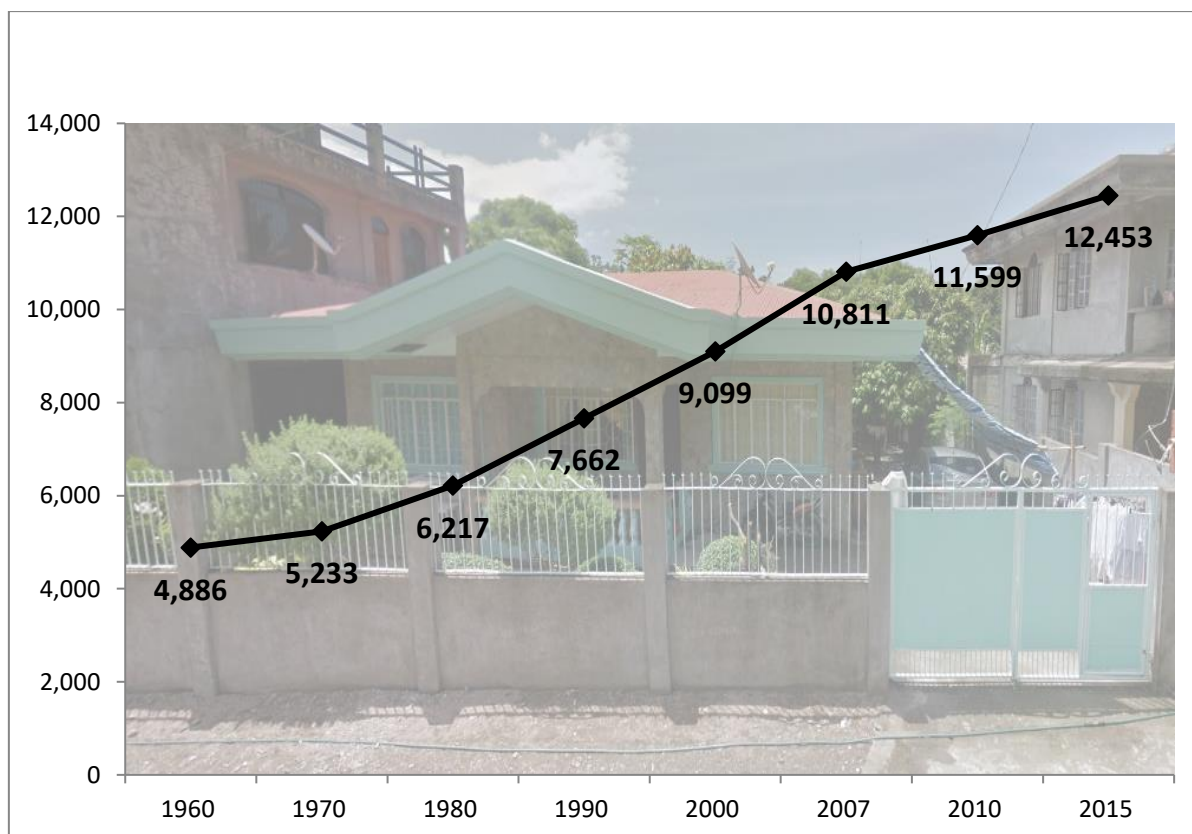

### Occupied housing units in Ragay reaches 12,453 in 2015

The number of occupied housing units in Ragay reached 12,453 in 2015, higher by 854 housing units compared with that in 2010. In 1960, there were only 4,886 housing units recorded. The number of housing units went up to 5,233 in 1970, 6,217 in 1980, 7,662 in 1990, 9,099 in 2000, 10,811 in 2007, 11,599 in 2010, and 12,453 in 2015. The number of housing units in Ragay increased by 7,567 from 1960 to 2015.

## There are 100 households per 100 occupied housing units in Ragay

A total of 12,453 occupied housing units and 12,496 households were recorded in 2015 in Ragay. These translate to a ratio of 100 households for every 100 occupied housing units, with an average of 4.67 persons per occupied housing unit. In 2010, there were 100 households per 100 occupied housing units and an average of 4.70 persons per occupied housing unit. While in 2000, there were 101 households per 100 occupied housing units and 5.23 persons per housing unit.

## Majority of the occupied housing units are single houses

In 2015, single houses made up 95.62 percent of the total occupied housing units in Ragay. About 3.34 percent of the total occupied housing units were of duplex type while 0.59 percent were multi- unit residential buildings/houses. In 2010, single houses accounted for 98.55 percent of the total occupied housing units, 0.64 percent were duplex, and 0.48 percent were multi- unit residential buildings/houses.



### Occupied housing units with outer walls made of strong materials decrease in 2015

There were lesser occupied housing units with outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone in 2015 than in 2010 in Ragay. In 2015, 29.04 percent of the total occupied housing units had outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone. This was slightly lower than the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone recorded in 2010 (30.49%). On the other hand, the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of half concrete/brick/stone and half wood increased from 16.42 percent in 2010 to 20.14 percent in 2015. The proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of wood decreased from 7.71 percent in 2010 to 5.65 percent in 2015.

## Occupied housing units with roofs made of strong materials decrease in 2015

The proportion of occupied housing units with roofs made of galvanized iron/aluminum decreased in 2015 in Ragay. About 51.55 percent of the occupied housing units in 2015 had roofs made of galvanized iron/aluminum, which is lower than the proportion of 55.07 percent recorded in 2010. The proportion of occupied housing units with roofs made of bamboo/cogon/nipa/anahaw decreased from 40.93 percent in 2010 to 38.67 percent in 2015.

## Most households live in housing units they owned on rent-free lot with consent of owner

Of the 12,496 households in Ragay in 2015, 49.71 percent of the households lived in their own housing unit on rent-free lot but with consent of the owner. Moreover, owner 31.44 percent lived in a housing unit they owned or with owner-like possession of house and lot. In addition, 7.93 percent of the total households lived in rent-free house and lot with consent of owner.

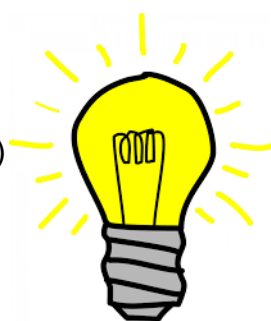

### Majority of the households in Ragay use electricity as fuel for lighting

Majority (78.79%) of the households in Ragay in 2015 used electricity as fuel for lighting, while kerosene (gaas) ranked second with 2,554 households using kerosene (gaas) as their source of fuel for lighting in 2015. Meanwhile, 96 households in Ragay used either LPG, oil, solar panel, solar lamp or other source as their fuel for lighting.

## Shared tubed/piped deep well is the main source of water supply for drinking in Ragay

Shared tubed/piped deep well was listed as the main source of water supply for drinking in Ragay in 2015. Of the 12,496 households, 2,995 households drew water supply for drinking from shared tubed/piped deep well while about 2,763 households drew water supply for drinking from shared faucet community water system. Own use faucet community water system was listed as the third main source of water supply for drinking for 1,888 households.

## 3,204 households in Ragay reported shared tubed/piped deep well as the main source of water supply for cooking

Shared tubed/piped deep well was reported as the main source of water supply for cooking in Ragay in 2015. Around 3,204 households shared tubed/piped deep well as the main source of water supply for cooking. Shared faucet community water system ranked second as the main source of water supply for cooking while dug well ranked third.
