HOUSING CHARACTERISTICS IN SIPOCOT (Results of the 2015 Census of Population)

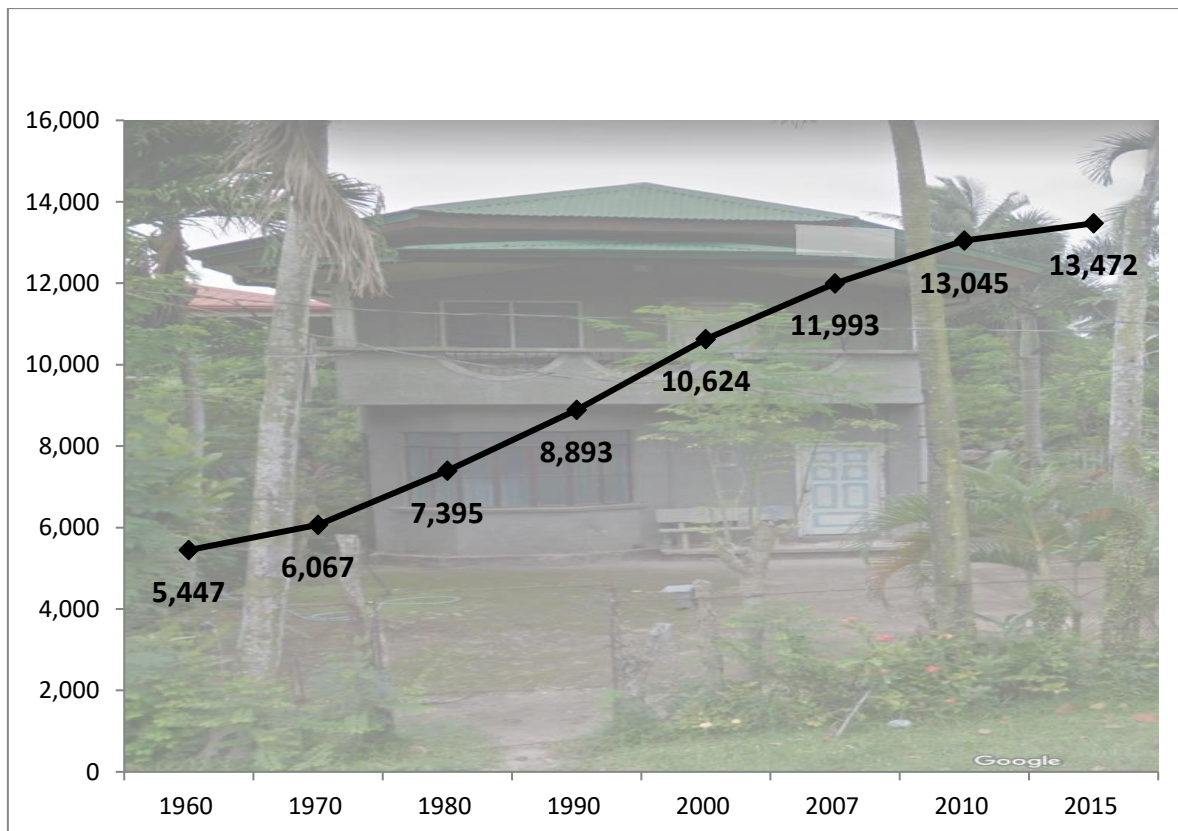
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Occupied housing units in Sipocot reaches 13,472 in 2015

The number of occupied housing units in Sipocot reached 13,472 in 2015, higher by 427 housing units compared with that in 2010. In 1960, there were only 5,447 housing units recorded. The number of housing units went up to 6,067 in 1970, 7,395 in 1980, 8,893 in 1990, 10,624 in 2000, 11,993 in 2007, 13,045 in 2010, and 13,472 in 2015. The number of housing units in Sipocot increased by 8,025 from 1960 to 2015.

There are 100 households per 100 occupied housing units in Sipocot

A total of 13,472 occupied housing units and 13,531 households were recorded in 2015 in Sipocot. These translate to a ratio of 100 households for every 100 occupied housing units, with an average of 4.81 persons per occupied housing unit. In 2010, there were 100 households per 100 occupied housing units and an average of 4.90 persons per occupied housing unit. While in 2000, there were 101 households per 100 occupied housing units and 5.33 persons per housing unit.

Majority of the occupied housing units are single houses

In 2015, single houses made up 97.85 percent of the total occupied housing units in Sipocot. About 1.59 percent of the total occupied housing units were of duplex type while 0.40 percent were multi- unit residential buildings/houses. In 2010, single houses accounted for 98.29 percent of the total occupied housing units, 117 housing units were duplex, and 58 housing units were multi- unit residential buildings/houses.



More occupied housing units with outer walls made of strong materials in 2015

There were more occupied housing units with outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone in 2015 than in 2010 in Sipocot. In 2015, 30.22 percent of the total occupied housing units had outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone. This was higher than the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone recorded in 2010 (27.42%). Similarly, the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of half concrete/brick/stone and half wood increased from 17.66 percent in 2010 to 19.80 percent in 2015. On the other hand, the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of wood decreased from 22.10 percent in 2010 to 18.68 percent in 2015.

Occupied housing units with roofs made of strong materials decrease in 2015

The proportion of occupied housing units with roofs made of galvanized iron/aluminum decreased in 2015 in Sipocot. About 62.16 percent of the occupied housing units in 2015 had roofs made of galvanized iron/aluminum, which is lower than the proportion of 63.61 percent recorded in 2010. The proportion of occupied housing units with roofs made of bamboo/cogon/nipa/anahaw also decreased from 30.53 percent in 2010 to 28.37 percent in 2015.

Most households live in housing units they owned or with owner-like possession of house and lot

Of the 13,531 households in Sipocot in 2015, 52.58 percent lived in a housing unit they owned or with owner-like possession of house and lot. Moreover, 35.85 percent of the households lived in their own housing unit on rent-free lot with consent of the owner. In addition, 3.72 percent of the total households lived in rent-free house and lot with consent of owner.

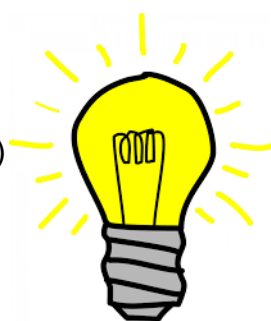

Majority of the households in Sipocot use electricity as fuel for lighting

Majority (85.13%) of the households in Sipocot in 2015 used electricity as fuel for lighting, while kerosene (gaas) ranked second with 1,963 households using kerosene (gaas) as their source of fuel for lighting in 2015. Meanwhile, 49 households in Sipocot used either LPG, oil, solar panel, solar lamp or other source as their fuel for lighting.

Own use faucet community water system is the main source of water supply for drinking in Sipocot

Own use faucet community water system was listed as the main source of water supply for drinking in Sipocot in 2015. Of the 13,531 households, 2,935 households drew water supply for drinking from own use faucet community water system while about 2,479 households drew water supply for drinking from shared faucet community water system. Protected spring was listed as the third main source of water supply for drinking for 2,003 households.

3,250 households in Sipocot reported own use faucet community water system as the main source of water supply for cooking

Own use faucet community water system was reported as the main source of water supply for cooking in Sipocot in 2015. Around 3,250 households used own use faucet community water system as the main source of water supply for cooking. Shared faucet community water system ranked second as the main source of water supply for cooking while dug well ranked third.
