## HOUSING CHARACTERISTICS IN TIGAON (Results of the 2015 Census of Population)

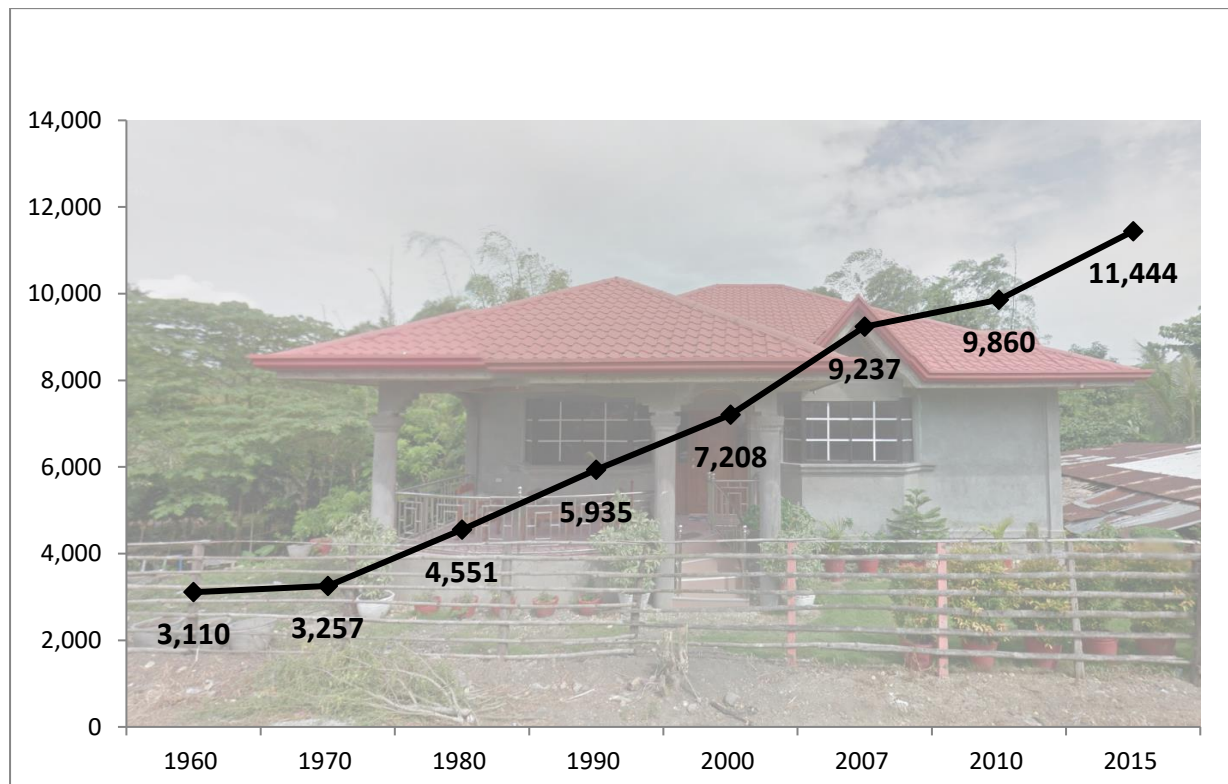
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### Occupied housing units in Tigaon reaches 11,444 in 2015

The number of occupied housing units in Tigaon reached 11,444 in 2015, higher by 1,584 housing units compared with that in 2010. In 1960, there were only 3,110 housing units recorded. The number of housing units went up to 3,257 in 1970, 4,551 in 1980, 5,935 in 1990, 7,208 in 2000, 9,237 in 2007, 9,860 in 2010, and 11,444 in 2015. The number of housing units in Tigaon increased by 8,334 from 1960 to 2015.

## There are 101 households per 100 occupied housing units in Tigaon

A total of 11,444 occupied housing units and 11,600 households were recorded in 2015 in Tigaon. These translate to a ratio of 101 households for every 100 occupied housing units, with an average of 4.82 persons per occupied housing unit. In 2010, there were 100 households per 100 occupied housing units and an average of 4.90 persons per occupied housing unit. While in 2000, there were 103 households per 100 occupied housing units and 5.58 persons per housing unit.

## Majority of the occupied housing units are single houses

In 2015, single houses made up 96.64 percent of the total occupied housing units in Tigaon. About 2.71 percent of the total occupied housing units were of duplex type while 0.41 percent were multi- unit residential buildings/houses. In 2010, single houses accounted for 96.54 percent of the total occupied housing units, 141 housing units were duplex, and 140 housing units were multi- unit residential buildings/houses.



### Lesser occupied housing units with outer walls made of strong materials in 2015

There were lesser occupied housing units with outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone in 2015 than in 2010 in Tigaon. In 2015, 37.22 percent of the total occupied housing units had outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone. This was lower than the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of concrete/brick/stone recorded in 2010 (42.70%). On the other hand, the proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of half concrete/brick/stone and half wood increased from 13.03 percent in 2010 to 16.15 percent in 2015. The proportion of occupied housing units with outer walls made of wood decreased from 7.46 percent in 2010 to 5.36 percent in 2015.

## Occupied housing units with roofs made of strong materials decrease in 2015

The proportion of occupied housing units with roofs made of galvanized iron/aluminum decreased in 2015 in Tigaon. About 51.79 percent of the occupied housing units in 2015 had roofs made of galvanized iron/aluminum, which is lower than the proportion of 62.96 percent recorded in 2010. The proportion of occupied housing units with roofs made of bamboo/cogon/nipa/anahaw increased from 27.96 percent in 2010 to 36.13 percent in 2015.

## Most households live in housing units they owned or with owner-like possession of house and lot

Of the 11,600 households in Tigaon in 2015, 44.38 percent lived in a housing unit they owned or with owner-like possession of house and lot. Moreover, 42.37 percent of the households lived in their own housing unit on rent- free lot but with consent of the owner. In addition, 4.29 percent of the total households lived in rent-free house and lot with consent of owner.

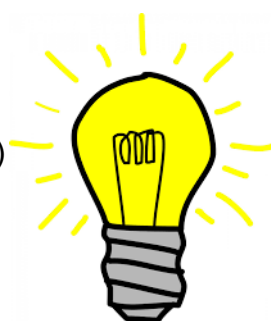

### Majority of the households in Tigaon use electricity as fuel for lighting

Majority (82.03%) of the households in Tigaon in 2015 used electricity as fuel for lighting, while kerosene (gaas) ranked second with 1,929 households using kerosene (gaas) as their source of fuel for lighting in 2015. Meanwhile, 155 households in Tigaon used either LPG, oil, solar panel, solar lamp or other source as their fuel for lighting.

### Own use faucet community water system is the main source of water supply for drinking in Tigaon

Own use faucet community water system was listed as the main source of water supply for drinking in Tigaon in 2015. Of the 11,600 households, 3,141 households drew water supply for drinking from own use faucet community water system while about 2,893 households drew water supply for drinking from shared faucet community water system. Shared tubed/piped deep well was listed as the third main source of water supply for drinking for 2,115 households.

### 3,169 households in Tigaon reported own use faucet community water system as the main source of water supply for cooking

Own use faucet community water system was reported as the main source of water supply for cooking in Tigaon in 2015. Around 3,169 households used own use faucet community water system as the main source of water supply for cooking. Shared faucet community water system ranked second as the main source of water supply for cooking while shared tubed/piped deep well ranked third.
